  - NO EXHIBITOR MAY LEAVE THE SHOW GROUND BEFORE THE GRAND PARADE AND CANNOT LEAVE UNTIL THEY HAVE COLLECTED THEIR PASSPORTS
  - EACH INDIVIDUAL ANIMAL MAY ONLY ENTER ONE CLASS PLUS A PAIRS CLASS IN THEIR APPLICABLE SECTIONS AND THE YOUNG HANDLERS CLASS.
  - CALVES AT FOOT SHOULD BE NOTED ON THE ENTRY FORM TO ALLOW CORRECT LINEAGE TO BE ALLOCATED. ALL CALVES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THEIR OWN FULL PASSPORT
