SHOW RULES

- 1, Entries to all classes are free, prizes will be awarded.
- 2, Entries to be staged by 6pm on the 21st July, the Marquee will be open from 11am.
- **3**, Exhibitors with 6 or more entries will receive a show ticket, to be collected from the steward when the entries are staged.
- 4, All classes are open to Amateur Gardeners & Flower Arrangers.
- 5, Vegetables and Cut Flowers must be grown by the Exhibitor.
- 6, All Arrangements to include all Fresh material.
- 7. Arrangements may be brought to the show ready assembled, but must be the competitors own work.
- **8,** Competitors to provide their own containers. However we do have a number of 17cm and 32cm containers, which anyone can borrow on a first come first served basis.
- 9, Only one entry per person per class.
- 10, The Judge's decision will be final.
- 11, Trophy & Section winners will be displayed on show day, the presentation will take place at the end of the day.
- 12, No entries may be removed from the marquee before 5.30pm, on Saturday 21st July.
- 13, No Late Entries will be accepted.
- 14, All Exhibits and personal property will be at the risk of the competitors, Mid Devon Show cannot accept responsibility for the loss or damage caused to any item.

- 1. Five White Potatoes.
- 2. Five Coloured Potatoes.
- 3. Three Carrots.
- 4. Three Beetroot.
- 5. Three Onion Sets.
- 6. Two Courgettes.
- 7. Six French Beans. (Dwarf or Climbing)
- 8. Six Runner Beans.
- 9. One Cucumber.
- 10. Six Tomatoes.
- 11. Six Cherry Tomatoes.
- 12. A Plate of Soft Fruit, 6 fruits one or more varieties.
- 13. A Wonky Vegetable.
- 14. A Collection of Vegetables, 4 varieties 3 of each, to be displayed area of no more than 70cm x 40cm.
- 15. Five Stems of mixed herbs.

CUT FLOWER CLASSES

- 16. Five Pansies.
- 17. A Single Rose.
- 18. A Fuchsia head in a Wine Glass.
- 19. Five Stems of Sweet Peas (any colour).
- 20. Three Pompom Dahlia Blooms.
- 21. Three Decorative Dahlia Blooms.
- 22. Three Cactus Dahlia Blooms.
- 23. Three Single Dahlia Blooms
- 24. A Sunflower Head.
- 25. Five Stems of Annual Garden Flowers, one or more varieties.
- 26. Five Stems of Garden Flowers, one or more varieties.
- 27. Three Stems of Gladioli.
- 28. Three Stems of Garden Shrub, one or more varieties.
- 29. A Planted Patio Container, Top of container not to exceed 40cm diameter/across.

FLOWER ARRANGING CLASSES

- 30. A Floral Display, Theme '75 years of the NHS', a pedestal or stand, other accessories may be used. To be staged on the ground, not to exceed 60cm (depth) x 90cm (width), height optional.
- 31. An Arrangement, Theme 'Coronation', accessories may be used, not to exceed 45cm x 45cm, height optional.
- 32. An Arrangement using a Biscuit Tin, accessories may be used, not to exceed 45cm x 45cm, height optional.
- 33. An Arrangement in a Tea Pot, accessories may be used, not to exceed 45cm x 45cm, height optional.
- 34. An Arrangement using only foliage. No accessories, not to exceed 45cm x 45 cm, height optional.
- 35. A Miniature Arrangement, not exceeding 15cm in any direction.

CHILDREN'S CLASSES

Open to children under the age of 16 on the day of the show. Entries will be judged according to age, please enter the age you will be on the day of the show on the entry forms.

- 36. A Miniature Garden in a Seed Tray, no larger than 25cm x 40cm.
- 37. An Edible Necklace.
- 38. A Planted Butter Tub.
- 39. A Flower Arrangement in a Cup & Saucer, not to exceed 30cm x 30cm, height optional.
- 40. A Picture of a House with a Garden, A4 size picture.
- 41. A Homemade Crown.
