

FLOWER ARRANGING CLASSES

33. A Floral Display, Theme '100 Years of Winnie The Pooh', a pedestal or stand, other accessories may be used. To be staged on the ground, not to exceed 60cm (depth) x 90cm (width), height optional.
34. An Arrangement, Theme '150 years since the First Telephone', accessories may be used, not to exceed 45cm x 45cm, height optional.
35. An Arrangement using a Sporting item, other accessories may be used, not to exceed 45cm x 45cm, height optional.
36. An Arrangement using Wood, other accessories may be used, not to exceed 45cm x 45cm, height optional.
37. An Arrangement using only foliage. No accessories, not to exceed 45cm x 45cm, height optional.
38. Floating Flowers, not exceeding 35cm in diameter.
39. A Buttonhole, one or more flowers.

CHILDREN'S CLASSES

Open to children under the age of 16 years on the day of the show. Under 8 years must be under 8 on the day of the show. The Judges are asked to judge entries according to age, their decision is final. Please enter the age you will be on the day of the show on the entry forms.

No entries may be removed from the marquee before 5.30pm, on Saturday 26th July.

1. Entries to all classes are free, prize cards will be awarded.
2. Entries to be staged by 5.30pm on the 24th July, the Marquee will be open from 12noon.
3. Exhibitors with 6 or more entries will receive a show ticket, to be collected from the steward when the entries are staged.
4. All classes are open to Amateur Gardeners & Flower Arrangers.
5. Vegetables and Cut Flowers must be grown by the Exhibitor.
6. All Arrangements to include all Fresh material unless specified in the schedule.
7. Arrangements may be brought to the show ready assembled, but must be the competitors own work.
8. Competitors to provide their own containers. However we do have a number of 17cm and 32cm containers, which anyone can borrow on a first come first served basis.
9. Only one entry per person per class.
10. The Judge's decision will be final.
11. The presentation of Trophies will take place at the end of the day.
12. **No entries may be removed from the marquee before 5.30pm, on Saturday 25th July.**
13. All staged entries to be removed at the end of the show.
14. No Late Entries will be accepted.
15. All Exhibits and personal property will be at the risk of the competitors.
16. Mid Devon Show cannot accept responsibility for the loss or damage caused to any item.
