BEEF AND DAIRY CATTLE SCHEDULE RULES

The Special Cattle Rules shown below are applicable and binding on all exhibitors of the Cattle Section. Also, the general rules of the Society, which are available on request or to be viewed on website www.nantwichshow.org

1. The showground is licensed by DEFRA and the regulations relating to the movement of cattle will apply.
2. **ALL CATTLE** must be registered in appropriate Herd Books.
3. **BEEF CATTLE** all to be full pedigree
4. **ALL ANIMALS:** yo be in the **ownership of the exhibitor by 28 June 2024**
5. **CONTROL OF BULLS: EXHIBITORS RESPONSIBILITY IN SHOW RING:** It is recommended that there is to be one person using a rope or chain attached to a halter with a second rope or chain attached directly to the nose-ring or via the nose-ring to the halter, with a competent person standing by able to assist in the control of the bull if necessary. A staff should be used should the temperament of the bull deem it necessary.
6. **STALLS:** During the period the Show is open to the public, mature bulls in stalls or pens should not be left unattended. If the handler is temporarily absent, arrangements should be made with another exhibitor or steward to oversee the bull until the handler returns.
7. **MINIMUM ENTRIES-** The chief steward reserves the right to amalgamate any breed with insufficient entries.
8. **No overstocking, sealing of teats, taping or additional shaping of udders of cows or heifers in milk allowed and any animal overstocked may be disqualified at the discretion of the Chief Cattle Steward. There will be spot checks taking place and any of the above will lead to disqualification.** The infusion of drugs in any form or to any part of the animal are not permitted. The Judge may require any animal to be milked out in his presence so that he may form an opinion of the udder after milking. Cattle lines will be monitored throughout the show. Any artificial contrivance or device of any description found on or proved to have been used on an animal at any time whilst that animal is at the showground, either for preventing the flow of milk or for any other improper purpose, will disqualify that animal from being awarded a prize, and any prize awarded prior to the discovery will be forfeited. The Instigator or The Owner of said animal may be prohibited from again entering stock for any of the Society's Shows, for such period as the Committee may see fit. For the purpose of this Regulation, the term 'improper practice' shall be held to include setting of teats and generally any other practice including tampering of their own or any other animal by the exhibitor or any other person which results in the animals being shown other than in a natural state, and the Society reserves the right to have all animals inspected by the Society's Veterinary Officers, either prior to, during, or after judging. The Society will not tolerate the administration to show exhibits (entered either for competition or sale/demonstration) of tranquillisers or other drugs which may in any way affect the performance of the animal in question to have the effect of making it behave in the show ring in a manner which is not natural. The society reserves the right to take any necessary samples. Any person or exhibitor (or his representative) who is found to have administered or permitted the administration of any such tranquilliser or drugs to any Show Exhibit will be reported to the organising committee, and dealt with at their discretion. In addition the matter will be referred to the appropriate Breed Society or Organisation. Any Exhibitor wishing to lodge an objection, having reference to Livestock exhibited at this show, must make the same in accordance with the objection requirements of the Society. If, on investigation, the objection is not sustained to the satisfaction of the Committee, the sum thus deposited shall, at the discretion of the Committee, be forfeited to the funds of the Society. All objections must be lodged on the same day as the alleged incident occurred in accordance with the objection regulations, and no objection will be SUBSEQUENTLY received, unless a reason satisfactory to the Committee be assigned for the delay.
9. **In-calf cows or heifers** in all breeds must be served to calve within four months of the day of the Show. Should the Judge be in any doubt that any animal may not calve within four months, prize money will be withheld until evidence of calving is proved.
10. **SUBSTITUTES: Entries will close on 16th July 2024 after which substitute entries – providing they are in the same class may be made up to 7 days prior to the show, i.e. 23rd July. After this date no other substitute animals will be allowed. In the case of in-calf cattle which have calved by Show Day they may be included in the appropriate in-milk classes.**

11. **JUDGING:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be present in the judging ring for commencement of judging of appropriate classes, otherwise he/she will be eliminated.
12. **GRAND PARADE:** A Grand Parade of Cattle will be held within the Main Ring commencing at approx 2.00 pm – winners of each class MUST PARADE in order to receive prize money
13. **SAFETY:** It is the intention of the Show Committee to take all precautions possible for safety of all animals and persons on the showground and to implement the recommendations of the health and Safety Authorities. **Cows will not be allowed in judging rings for calf classes.**
14. **HEALTH STATUS;** All guide-lines issued by the Ministry will be carefully adhered to.
15. **CONTAGIOUS DISEASES:** Any animal appearing at the Show so affected will not be allowed onto the showground – this will be strictly enforced by the Stewards.
16. **TRAFFIC/VEHICLE PARKING:** It should be clearly understood that vehicles carrying cattle vehicle passes will only be allowed on the showground if transporting cattle; otherwise they will be routed to the appropriate vehicle park. Special rules reference to DEFRA requirements should be read and clearly held to.
17. **INTERPRETATION OF RULES:** The above rules are binding on all exhibitors, as also are the general rules of the Society.
18. **HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY:** Your attention is drawn to the Society policy which can be viewed on website www.nantwichshow.org
19. **PASSPORTS:** Any animal born on or after 1st July 1996 must have a passport, and this must accompany the animal to the show. Where Calves are involved they must have their own passport (CPP12) irrespective if it is Calf with Dam or calf for independent Calf Classes
20. **JOINT ENTRIES;** see note on page 4 re restriction of points.
21. All exhibitors must keep cattle lines clear of litter/waste at all times, and at conclusion of Show should remove unused feed, rubbish etc
22. **CONDUCT OF EXHIBITORS AND THEIR EMPLOYEES/REPRESENTATIVES:** The Society reserves the right to ban from exhibiting or attending, whomsoever in their opinion contravenes or has contravened any of the Society's bye-laws or regulations or who behaves noisily or offensively to Judges, Members of Council, Steward, Official, Exhibitor or Member of the Public. Any exhibitor deemed to be in breach of this regulation is liable to be disqualified and any award cancelled, and such person thereupon may be excluded from exhibiting at future Shows of the Society.
23. **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT:** Exhibitors must make sure that their portable electrical appliances have been PAT tested. These appliances should always be maintained properly and remain in good working order.
24. **GDPR:** The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) became a legal requirement on 25 May 2018. The Nantwich Show Cattle Society is committed to protecting your data. This brief policy sets out the basis on which any personal data that you provide to us, or that we may receive from others about you, will be processed. Data may be held electronically or in paper format and will only be held for a reasonable length of time.
