LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS OBLIGATIONS

The health and wellbeing of all animals and people present during the Nantwich Show is of paramount importance to the organisers. As such we would like to remind all livestock exhibitors of their responsibilities with respect to the health of their animals.

Only fit and healthy animals should be transported to the show. Any clinical signs of disease, however mild, detected on farm must result in the identified animals remaining at home and under no circumstances be brought to the showground. If an animal displays any signs or symptoms of illness once at the showground, the organisers must be alerted immediately. All animals brought to the showground must be accompanied by the relevant paperwork.

Thank you for your support in helping to keep all livestock and visitors healthy and happy.

SHEEP SECTION RULES

The Special Competitive Sheep Rules shown below are applicable and binding on all exhibitors of the section. Also, the General Rules of the Society which are available on request and printed in the Show catalogue are binding on all concerned.

- The showground is licensed by DEFRA and any regulations relating to sheep will apply
- **2.** Entries are welcome from Maedi Visna Accredited Registered Flocks and Non accredited flocks. You must have a current SAC document available prior to unloading if you are entering an accredited sheep, or emailed in advance.
- **3.** All pedigree sheep to be registered with the appropriate Society and will be shown under Society Rules
- **4.** All Sheep should carry their UK tag and be accompanied by the relevant movement licence, to be shown before unloading takes place.
- **5.** Entry Fees: £10.00 inc. VAT per class
- **6.** Prize money: Prize money will be awarded for first, second and third places. Prizes awarded for classes with a minimum of 4 entries will be £20, £15 & £10. For classes of 3 entries or below prizes will be £15, £10 & £5
- **7.** Admission Tickets: One entry ticket will be allocated for single entries, 2 entry tickets will be allocated for 2 and so on, for a maximum of 3 tickets. These will include allocated parking permits
- **8.** Pens will be allocated according to entry, but if oversubscribed, the Show management reserves the right to restrict entries to a number relative to accommodation. Additional Pens may be purchased at £5 per pen if available.
- **9.** Classes will be as listed if sufficient entries, but the Nantwich Agricultural Society reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate as they so decide.
- **10.** Only entries which have been submitted via showing scene will be accepted. There will be no additional entries accepted on the day and no amendments will be made on the day

- 11. Showing will be organised in a recognised manner, each entry displaying the lot number as provided and all exhibitors in the Show Ring must wear white coats. It is the responsibility of the Exhibitors to be present in the Judging Rings for commencement of judging of appropriate class, otherwise they will be eliminated.
- **12.** Breed Championships: All Class winners **except** Group winners will go forward to their respective breed Championship.
- **13.** Inter Breed Championship all Breed and Reserve Breed Champions will go forward to the Inter Breed Championships
- **14.** Breed champions will be invited into the main ring for the Grand Parade
- 15. Vehicles/Parking: One vehicle with trailer pass will be provided for each exhibitor which will gain access to the showground and entrance to the Designated Animal Area (DAA) from 6.00am with no movement of vehicles after 7.45 am. ALL VEHICLES moved to Sheep Section Vehicle Park where the vehicle will remain until loading at 3.00 pm (after Grand Parade). No other vehicles will be allowed in the designated parking area, any helpers or additional vehicles must park in the normal parking areas.
- **16.** Fodder etc: It should be clearly noted that hay and straw **WILL NOT** be provided.
- 17. Penning for all sheep will be outside Exhibitors to bring cover as required at their own risk.
- **18.** Safety: It is the intention of the Nantwich Agricultural Society to take all precautions possible for safety of all animals and persons on the showground and to implement the recommendations of the Health and Safety Authorities. Health & Safety Policy is available on request
- **19.** Any further rules necessary will be made by the Nantwich Agricultural Society at any time up to and including Show Day and such will be binding on all concerned.
- **20.** All Sheep must have been in the ownership of the exhibitor by 1st June 2025
- **21.** Nantwich Agricultural Society complies with all aspects of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Entries

Entries are invited for 2025 born lambs (ewes and tups will be judged separately), shearling ewe, shearling tup, aged ewe (2+ years) or aged tup (2+ years) as per sheep schedule. Up to 3 entries are invited per class

Awards

Society awards will be given for Champion and Reserve Champion where provided by the Society. Trophies awarded to Class Champion. Rosettes to 4th place and for all Young Handlers

Prize money

Prize money will be awarded to all classes with 4 or more entries. Supreme Champion \pounds 75.00, Reserve Champion \pounds 50.00. All classes - 1st prize - \pounds 20.00, 2nd prize - \pounds 15.00, 3rd prize - \pounds 10.00 (4 entries or more) or \pounds 15, \pounds 10 & \pounds 5 (3 entries or less)
