“MAGIC”

Class 1. Spellbound: An exhibit.

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

Class 2. Magic Potion: A petite exhibit.

Not to exceed 25cm width, 25cm depth and 37cm height

Class 3. Whispers: An exhibit.

Foliage to predominate.

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional

IMPORTANT

1. All sizes are approximate.
2. All classes are to be brought in prepared and ready to assemble.
3. All classes are to be staged on tabling approximately 75cm high.
4. The staging and backcloth are of a mushroom colour.
5. The backcloth will be approximately 100cm above the table. Exhibits may exceed this if required.
6. Nothing is to be attached to the backcloth.
7. The use of aerosol sprays inside the marquee is not permitted.
8. Only one entry per class.
9. All exhibits left at owners risk.

RULES

All exhibits will be judged in accordance with NAFAS 'Competitions Manual' Third Edition 2015. The judges' decision will be final.

An exhibit is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified in a show schedule.

Exhibits must be staged at the show venue unless otherwise stated in the show schedule.

Disqualification will take place for the following reasons:-

- Failure to comply with any specific requirement of a class as stated in the show schedule e.g. the measurements or the components.

- Inclusion of fresh plant material that does not have the roots or the cut ends of stems in water retaining material.

Exceptions: Air plants, cacti, fruits, fungi, grass turf, lichen, moss, succulents, vegetables and long-lasting plant material WHICH WILL REMAIN TURGID FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW. (Definition of turgid – the state of firmness of plant tissue relating from adequate moisture causing the plant cells to be fully expanded).

- Inclusion of artificial plant material (unless specifically allowed in the show schedule).

For further details and definitions, please refer to the NAFAS Competitions Manual Third Edition 2015, in accordance with which all classes will be judged.

STAGING

Exhibits may be staged between 1.00pm and 3.00pm on Tuesday 25th July 2023.

Exhibits may be removed after 5.30pm on show day and must be cleared by 6.30pm.

JUDGING

Judging will commence at 3.30pm on Tuesday 25th July 2023.

In addition Class 1 “Spellbound” will also be judged as “Peoples Choice” and voted on by the general public. Voting to close at 3.00pm on show day.

Prizes for all classes: 1st £10, 2nd £7, 3rd £4
