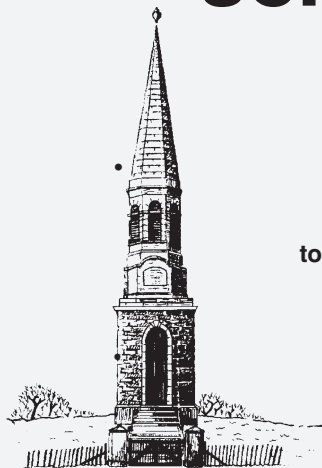

## **NEW DEER AGRICULTURAL ASSOCIATION ANNUAL SHOW**

- **All entries must be submitted by Wednesday 24th June 2026.**
- Tickets bearing your Catalogue numbers, and ADMIT passes will be sent to you before the day of the show
- **It is the responsibility of exhibitors to ensure that all vehicles bearing stock into the showground have been disinfected. There will not be any disinfecting facilities at the showground.**
- **All stock must be in the showground by 8.30 a.m. and not to be removed until after 2.30 p.m. No vehicles to be moved until after the Parade.**
- All stock shown at the Exhibitors own risk
- All stock should be adequately insured.
- All Cross Cattle will be penned
- **No warble infected cattle allowed**
- **All Horses must be in Parade or any prize money will be forfeited**
- Late Horse entries will be taken, however, entrants will not be in catalogue and an additional charge of £10 will be incurred. No Horse entries will be accepted on the day of the Show. No late entries will be taken for Sheep, Cattle & Goats.
- **All Trophies to be returned to the Secretary on Show Day or no later than 31st July, 2026.**
- **No refunds will be given**
- **All exhibitors should read NDAA Risk Assessments and Health and Safety Policy – these are available to read in the office.**

# ASSOCIATION RULES

- Membership, £25.00. Entries from Members Only. A Child under the age of 16 can enter ONE animal ONLY under the Membership of his/her parent or guardian for the entry fee only. (Restricted to one child per household). Any entries not paid prior to printing of catalogue may not appear in catalogue on show day. **Late Horse entries will be taken only until Wednesday prior to show, however, entrants will not be in the catalogue and an additional charge of £10 will be incurred. NO OTHER LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED (WHETHER RECEIVED BY LATE MAIL OR TELEPHONE) AFTER THE CATALOGUE DOCUMENTATION AND ENTRIES HAVE BEEN FORWARDED TO THE PRINTERS.** Any postal entries so received will be returned to the sender by First-Class Post. Any cheques returned by our Bank as unpaid will incur an additional charge of £20 to cover administrative costs.
- Members entering stock MUST INCLUDE THE **MEMBERSHIP MONEY** WITH THE APPROPRIATE ENTRY FEES. Those wishing to retain their membership but who cannot or will not be at the Show should send their money within 10 days of the Show date to the Secretary.
- Age of Cattle to be reckoned from Show Date, and to be accounted one year old at the second show following, and so on. One-year-old must not show hard teeth.
- Cows to be shown must be in Calf or in Milk. Ewes must have had a Lamb between 1st December and date of Show.
- The Stock must, at date of entry, be bona fide the property of the member in whose name entered.
- All animals competing in Pure Bred Classes must be entered or eligible for entry in their respective Herd Books.
- Competitors are required to see to the placing of their stock before the Judges for the various prizes for which they intend to compete. The Committee will not be responsible if the stock is not so placed at the proper time. No one will be allowed inside the Judging Ring at the time of Judging except the Committee in charge, and those in charge of the animals being shown.
- A Reserve Animal will be chosen for every Special Prize, so that in the case of Any Prize Animal being found unconforming to the regulations, the next in merit shall take the premier place.

- All exhibitors entering the Parade with a bull ANY age must adhere to the LEGAL age requirement of exhibitor leading the animal. Leaders must be over 16 and under 65 years of age. All stock must remain on the showground until after the parade.
- The Annual General Meeting will be held in November where accounts will be examined, and officials elected for the next year.
- Objections must be lodged with the Secretary in writing no later than 1pm on the day of the show. All complaints must include a deposit of £25 which shall be forfeited to the Association if the protest is dismissed. The committee would then meet to consider any protests and have the power to settle all disputes. Their decision will be final against which there will be no appeal.
- Only Association Prizes will be counted in a Most Successful Competition. 3 for a First, 2 for a Second, 1 for a Third.
- The Exhibitors, Caterers and Public are at their own risk, the Association undertaking no responsibility for any accident, loss or damage to person or property that may occur at the Show or in transit.
- Accommodation will be given in the Showyard to merchants for the exhibition or sale of goods approved by the Committee, at a charge to be agreed.
- No change can be made in these Rules except by regular meeting of Executive Committee.
- Entry Money for all Stock entered in Catalogue must be paid, regardless of non-appearance at Show.
- The Association retains the right to split classes if so required.
- All cattle (including calves) coming to the show must come from a herd that is fully accredited free of BVD or they must all be individually tested free of virus (antigen) whether or not they have been vaccinated, in accordance with CHECHS rules ([www.chechs.co.uk](http://www.chechs.co.uk))

## **Judging starts at 8.30am**

**8.30am** - Sports Horse, Thoroughbreds & Hunters, Irish Draught, Riding & Hunter Ponies in Hand, Arabs, Highland Ponies, Potential Ride & Drive, Shetland Ponies, Coloured Horses & Ponies, Veteran Horses & Ponies, Mountain & Moorland, Ridden Ponies & Hunter & Hacks and Working Hunter, Clydesdales & Clydesdale pure or part pure under saddle.

**11.45am** - Shetland Pony Championship

Horses and Ponies may be entered in more than one class. However, if an Exhibitor has entered more than one class and both are being judged at the same time, exhibitors must decide which class to enter. No judging will be delayed to enable exhibitors to enter both.

All ridden class competitors must wear headgear conforming to EN1384 or above (PAS 015 or ASTM).

All passports must be taken to the show to be made available for inspection at any time.

**All horses awarded prizes 1st to 3rd must attend the Grand Parade, failure to do so may forfeit prize money.**

## **Caledonian Showing Championships**

This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which is now fully established as the biggest and best way to end Scottish showing season

This year's show will be held at

***Howe EC, near Ladybank, Fife 16th to 18th October, 2026***

Every horse & pony placed 1st in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Puddledub Show's Facebook page and the website <https://puddledubshows.weebly.com/>

## **Irish Draught**

This show is affiliated to the Irish Draught Society (GB) and as such all exhibitors in classes 15, 16, 17 & 18 must be eligible under the below criteria:-

- All horses must be registered with or over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership
- Owners of Pure Bred Irish Draughts and Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) must be full members of the IDHS (GB) to compete

- Irish Draught Part Breds (Sport Horse) are horses that have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding
- In hand breeding classes
- MARES with foals at foot, 3 years and over must be inspected and classified as Class 1 (or RID), Class 2 or Supplementary Grade Up (or AID)
- Pure Bred youngstock must be the progeny of an inspected Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register.
- Pure Bred ID and ID Part Bred (Sport Horse), 3 year old colts must be un-inspected
- All 1, 2 & 3 year old colts must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler over 18 years of age

**GENERAL QUALIFIER INFORMATION:**

- The Finals of all IDHS (GB) qualifiers will be held at the IDHS (GB) National Championship Show on 5th & 6th September 2026 at Pickering Grange Equestrian, Pickering Grange Farm, Ellistown, Terrance Road, Coalville, LE67 1EZ.
- All owners of qualified horses will be contacted by a member of the IDHS (GB) Show Affiliation Team
- Horses can only qualify for a specific Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered.

**The Young Handler Scheme and The Young Handler Final are generously sponsored by The James Bennett Fund.**

\*Class 8 - An engraved medal is presented by The Clydesdale Horse Society to the best young handler aged 12 - 16. That person will also receive a Young Handler qualifier rosette on the day of the show. Qualifiers from any show held prior to 30th April in any year will qualify for the Young Handler final at the Royal Highland Show in the year of that show. Qualifier after 30th April in any year will qualify for Young Handler Final at the following

year's Royal Highland Show. A merit rosette will be given to all entrants in the class. The James Bennett Fund generously sponsors the Young Handler Scheme and The Young Handler Final.

\*\*Class 9 - This class is a qualifier for the Ridden Clydesdale Championship to be held at Scone Palace International Horse Trials on Thursday 27 August 2026. The first two PURE BRED CLYDESDALES to qualify. Qualification may go down to fourth place, if horses placed 1st and 2nd have previously qualified. Registered Clydesdales and those eligible for registration may qualify and enter for the Championship.

### **Judging to commence in the Main Ring after the Sport Horse**

This show is a Qualifier for The Irish Draught Owners & Breeders Group Youngstock Challenge. The two highest placed Pure-Breds from each age group not already qualified in Class 17 will qualify. If one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line in each age group will qualify. Horses entered into this class must be eligible under the criteria listed on page 5/6 . At the final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semifinalists from each class going forward to the Championship. The Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150.

Irish Draught & Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) Mare / Brood Mare: Irish Draught inspected mare, three years old and over, with own foal at foot, barren or in foal OR Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) mare three years old and over, barren / in foal / or with own foal at foot, registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.
16. Irish Draught & Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) Filly or Colt Foal: eligible for Class 1 on the Irish Draught Breed Register OR eligible for the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.
17. Irish Draught / Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) Youngstock - Yearling, two and three year old filly, gelding or colt either by a Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) sire out of an inspected Irish Draught dam or, ID Part Bred of at least 25% proven Irish Draught Breeding.
