Regulations for Competitors

Entries to be judged according to the NAFAS Competitors Manual 4th edition 2023. All Classes are open to everyone (except novice and under 16 classes). Floral fibre or Agra wool may be used in no foam classes. All measurements are approximate. Plant material to predominate.

- 1. NOTICE OF ENTRY** - Intending Competitors must give notice in writing, on the form provided by Friday 30th June 2026 or by online application via our New Forest Show website www.newforestshow.co.uk/exhibitors/competitions/
- 2. EXHIBITS** in all classes must be the work of the Competitor and must be arranged in the Marquee on Staging Day, UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE IN THE SCHEDULE.
- 3.** Bases and drapes are allowed but must be free standing.
- 4.** Water tap and a power point will be available. Any equipment used by exhibitors (if over 1 year old) must be PAT tested.
- 5. COMPETITORS** may enter only one exhibit in each class.
- 6. TICKETS & VEHICLE PASSES will be issued in the Marquee on Staging Day.** COMPETITORS will receive ONE Exhibitors Entry pass (admission for one person for all three days) and a vehicle pass.
Class 8 will receive one vehicle pass and TWO Exhibitor Entry passes.
- 7. THE SHOW COMMITTEE** will decide the position of all exhibits. Watering of exhibits will be carried out by Committee members.
- 8. RECEPTION OF EXHIBITS** - Exhibits will be received from 9.30am to 6.00pm, on the Monday prior to the show and must be finished that evening by 6.30pm.
- 9. ALL VEHICLES** must be moved to the Exhibitors 'PURPLE' Car Park, by 8am on all Show Days.
- 10. REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS.** Exhibits may be removed from 5.00pm on the third day of the Show. All base stands plinths must be left in a good state.
- 11. TROPHIES** to be returned to the Show Office by 1st March 2027. TROPHIES are perpetual and cannot be won outright.
- 12. The DECISION of the JUDGE** shall be final. Protests must be handed, in writing, to the Chair, together with a deposit of £5 before noon on the first day of the Show. Such protests will only be considered if referring to some infraction of the rules and if not sustained, the deposit will be forfeited. A Quorum of three, consisting of two Stewards and the Society CEO, will consider any such protest and their decision which will be given, if possible, before the close of the Show, shall be final.
- 13. SPECIAL NOTICE-** The most careful arrangements will be made for the presentation of articles on exhibition, but the New Forest Agricultural Show Society will not be responsible for the loss of any exhibits or any damage they may sustain on their way to, during, or from the Exhibition Area
