

RULES & REGULATIONS

Entries

1. The closing date for entries is 16 September 2022. Entries should be made as early as possible, only those received before the closing date will be catalogued, judged and space allocated accordingly.
2. Entries can be made through our online entry system and are free of charge, www.newarkvintagetractorshow.com/exhibitors.html.
3. Entries will still be accepted by post, but subject to a £5 admin fee. Entries will not be processed without this fee. We are offering a £5 rebate to any exhibitor who posts their entry back to us during the month of July. All paper entries received after 31st July will not receive this rebate.
4. Exhibitors from the same household/address should enter under one name, e.g. Smith Family or Mr & Mrs Smith.
5. Information from entry forms will be stored on a computer and the name, address and details of entries will be published in the Catalogue unless otherwise advised to the Society. Information about results may also be published and/or provided to the press, clubs and societies for publication.
6. The making of an entry is irrevocable consent for the storage and disclosure of information in this way.
7. Exhibitors participating in this Show must hold an appropriate valid Insurance Policy.
8. **Exhibitor wristbands** are allocated based on 2 wristbands for the first entry to a maximum of 4 wristbands.

1 tractor/exhibit	2 wristbands
2- 3 tractors/exhibits	3 wristbands
4 or more tractors/exhibits	4 wristbands

Any other passes required for friends and family will be heavily subsidised at £15 for a weekend pass. Wristbands are valid for both days of the show and **must be worn at all times** whilst on the Showground.

Wristbands are complimentary and are not for re-sale. Anyone found to be selling exhibitor wristbands will have their entries withdrawn without any fees being refunded.

- 2 **Camping passes:** Each exhibitor is entitled to 1 free Weekend Camping pass. **There is no access to the camping area without a pass.** Electrical hook ups are available for £30.00. Hook ups must be booked and paid for before the close of entries. Information on camping pitches will be forwarded once pitches have been booked.
- 3 **Additional wristbands, camping passes and electrical hook ups** can be purchased through the online entry system or paper entry forms.

- 4 All passes will be ready to collect at the Blue Gate office on arrival at the Showground. They will be in exhibitor packs along with your exhibit numbers and your exhibit cards.

Times

- 5 The gates are open for exhibitors on Thursday 3rd November from 1pm - 6pm hours and on Friday 4th November from 8am - 7pm hours. Entry on Saturday morning is via the Blue Gate from 7am - 8am only. No vehicle movement will be allowed while the Show is open to the public. There will be no entry before 1pm Thursday.
- 6 The Show is open between 9am & 5pm on Saturday and 9am & 3.30pm on Sunday. Exhibitors must attend both days. PLEASE NOTE THAT YOUR EXHIBIT MUST BE IN PLACE AT THE SHOW BY 8.30am ON BOTH DAYS AND MAY NOT LEAVE UNTIL AN ANNOUNCEMENT IS MADE TO SAY THAT IT IS SAFE TO DO SO AFTER THE SHOW FINISHES AT APPROXIMATELY 3.45pm ON THE SUNDAY.

Arrival/Departure

- 7 All exhibitors must wear a High Visibility Jacket or Vest during build up & breakdown.
- 8 Exhibitors of tracked or metal-wheeled vehicles **must** seek advice from their Stewards on arrival and before unloading. Road bands are preferred on metal-wheeled tractors.
- 9 Once tractors are in position, all batteries must be disconnected.
- 10 Exhibits are to be unloaded on arrival. Exhibitors are welcome to sheet down their exhibit, but the sheet must be removed by 8.30am.
- 11 No-one is to advertise either the sale of an exhibit or other events without prior written agreement from the Show Manager.
- 12 No Tyre Wax may be put on the wheels once inside the hall.
- 13 Health & Safety requirements regarding emissions, STRICTLY NO ENGINE CAN BE STARTED UP OR VEHICLE MOVED UNTIL THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND TRADE EXHIBITORS ARE CLEAR OF THE AREA AND AUTHORITY HAS BEEN GIVEN BY HALL & OTHER SHOW STEWARDS. THE STEWARDS' WORD IS FINAL.

Judging of Entries

- 14 Your entry will be located based on the class it is entered in. Details of where your entry is to be positioned in the show will be provided with your exhibitor pre-show information.
- 15 The Society reserves the right to move exhibits if it sees fit to do so.
- 16 Judges will be briefed to find entries in their locations specified by the Society, any exhibit that is not in its correct location will not be judged.
