The organisers and each of the show's officers, servants or agents shall not be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to exhibitors or their servants or agents or other members of the public, to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought onto the showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving, or for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the show.
- 2. This show is run under the showing and competition rules of the National Pony Society (NPS). 3. In all classes the judge's decision is final.
- 4. Any person wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any persons or exhibit, shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class and at the same time shall deposit a sum of £20. If the investigation by the committee shows the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the show. The committee's decision will be final.
- 5. All Mountain and Moorland ponies must be registered with their respective breed society and be shown in accordance with their individual society rules.
- 6. The organisers reserve the right to amend the judges' panel and order of classes if it should become necessary.
- 7. The committee cannot be held responsible for the clashing of classes therefore competitors should bear this in mind when making their entries. No entry fees will be refunded.
- 8. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes if deemed necessary.
- 9. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries without giving a reason.
- 10. The committee reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fees in the event of the show being cancelled.
- 11. Rider's and handler's age, attire and equipment must comply with NPS showing and competition rules at the time of the show.
- 12. No pony under the age of 4 may compete in any ridden class.
- 13. Spurs are not allowed in any ridden class.
- 14. Anyone found mistreating a horse or pony may be asked to leave the showground and be reported to the appropriate body.

To be held at the NPS Spring festival on the Saturday 25th April 2020 At the Royal Three Counties Show ground, Malvern.

- 1. The NPS Area 10 Open Ridden Winter Championship Small Breeds. Stallions, mares and geldings five years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Dartmoor, Shetlands, Exmoor, Welsh A & B.
- 2. The NPS Area 10 Open Ridden Winter Championship Large Breeds. Stallions, mares and geldings five years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forrest, Welsh C & Welsh D.
- 3. The NPS/Hirstmund Stud M&M pure novice ridden winter championship Small Breeds. Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Dartmoor, Shetlands, Exmoor, Welsh A & B Ponies not to have been placed first in any ridden M&M class (excluding leading rein & first ridden) before the 1st September in the current season.
- 4. The NPS/Hirstmund Stud M&M pure novice ridden winter championship Large Breeds. Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forrest, Welsh C & Welsh D. Ponies not to have been placed first in any ridden M&M class (excluding leading rein & first ridden) before the 1st September in the current season.

- 5. The NPS/Leyhills Stud M&M in hand Winter Championship Small Breeds.1,2&3 year olds. Youngstock,colt's filly's and geldings, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Dartmoor, Shetlands, Exmoor, Welsh A & B.
- 6. The NPS/Leyhills Stud M&M in hand Winter Championship Small Breeds,4 Year olds and over. Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Dartmoor, Shetlands, Exmoor, Welsh A & B.
- 7. The NPS/Leyhills Stud M&M in hand Winter Championship Large Breeds 1,2 &3 year olds. Colts filly's and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Large Breeds; Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forrest, Welsh C & Welsh D.
- 8. The NPS/Leyhills Stud M&M in hand Winter Championship Large Breeds. 4 Year olds and over Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Large Breeds; Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forrest, Welsh C & Welsh D.

Handlers can be any age, except Stallions. (see rules in Sec A 3.2). The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter the competition or to qualify but the owner must be a qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final.

In each class the three highest placed ponies which have not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify for the final at the Spring festival. Winnings in the NPS Winter competitions will not debar novice ponies from entering NPS M&M novice ridden competitions.

- 10. The NPS/Showing classics M&M First Ridden National Championship. Mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Not exceeding 128cm. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January in the current year.
- 11. The NPS M&M Novice Leading rein National Championship, Kindly sponsored by The Kings head. Mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Not exceeding 122cm. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday by the 1st January in the current year. The pony never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Mountain & Moorland Leading Rein classes or qualified for the NPS M&M Leading Rein final before 1st January in the current year.
- 12. The NPS/Bryndefaid Stud M&M Novice First Ridden National Championship. Mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society stud book. Not exceeding 128cm. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January in the current year. The pony never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any First Ridden Mountain & Moorland classes or qualified for the NPS M&M First Ridden final before 1st January in the current year.

**13.The NPS/Ryehouse Native show team M&M Junior Ridden National.** A) & b), with a qualification awarded to the highest placed over 138cm and under 138cm in that class. a) Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A or B Mares and geldings 4 years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society book. Riders to be under 14 years of age. B) Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forrest, Connemara, Welsh C or D. Mares and geldings 4 years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective breed society book. Riders to be under 18 years of age.

Highest placed pony, owned by an NPS member to go forward to the final.

- 19. NPS/MENEDH STUD Show Hunter Pony In Hand National Championship. 2 & 3 year old in hand national championship. Colts, filly's and geldings not to exceed 153cms at maturity, registered in the NPS British riding pony stud book, register, appendix, international or sports pony section of the BRPSB; the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or registered in the main body of their respective mountain & moorland stud books. Highest placed pony owned by an NPS member to go forward to the final.
- 20. NPS/KELLYTHORPES STUD Open Ridden Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony Gold Medal Championship. Stallions mares or geldings 4 years and over.

Riders to be a suitable size for pony. Riders must be 12yrs old and over when riding stallion not exceeding 128cm and 14 years old & over when riding stallions exceeding 128cm. Show ponies not to exceed 148 cms. Show hunter ponies not to exceed 153cms. The highest places show pony and show hunter pony owned by an NPS member to go forward to the final. The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition or to qualify but the owner must be a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final.

Inhand/Ridden Show pony/ Show hunter pony Championship.

The owner does not have to be a member of the NPS member to enter this competition but only ponies owned by NPS qualifying or life members can qualify for the final. You will need to show you adult showing card to the judge in the ring to receive the qualification.
