HEALTH STATUS FOR ENTRIES

- a) SCRAPIE monitored goats; A current health certificate must be included with entries
- b) ALL OTHER GOATS; Entries will be restricted to goats from herds that are WHOLE HERD NEGATIVE tested within 12 months of the date of the show. BGS regulation 26 (b)(i) defines 'whole herd' for CAE testing purposes. Whole herd negative CAE tested means an entire herd in which all animals over one year old hold a current negative CAE test certificate, and all kids should have a current negative CAE test certificate for their dams. Entries will only be accepted from herds who's CAE blood test results are on BGS submission forms.

Unfortunately we are unable to facilitate goats from CAE Accredited herds due to not being able to meet the regulation requirements.

There will be a minimum 2 meter gap between herds from a) and b).

Exhibitors are advised that milk that has been through the communal weigh bucket should not be fed to kids, as this has been a factor in the spread of CAE.

UNCERTIFIED AND UNENTERED GOATS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON THE SHOWGROUND
