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## Schedule of Classes

**Class One: 80cm**

**Class Two: 90cm**

Both classes are for teams of three combinations only- all scores to count. Teams must have three different riders and horses/ponies can only jump once in a class.

Both classes will be run single phase. Distances will be as for horses as per the Pony Club Showjumping Rules.

**There is a limit of 15 teams per class; each Branch/Centre may only enter one team in each of the classes initially** – if there are still spaces before the closing date, then Branches/Centres may enter another team(s) in a class with space available.

*The competition will be run under The Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2026*

**Closing Date: Friday 29th May 2026 (will close early if full)**

**Entry Fee: £60 per team.**

Ten entry passes per team will be allocated: the passes will be sent to the Team Manager named on Showing Scene – entries are only to be made by DCs/Centre Proprietors/Team Managers.

**Rosettes** to sixth place, with sashes awarded to the winning team in each class.

**Presentation in the arena:** 1st – 3rd teams to be mounted.

4th – 6th rosettes to be collected ringside/from the judges' box.

All riders at presentation must be correctly turned out as per Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2026.

As a courtesy to Royal Three Counties Show, riders should wear white or beige jodphurs/breeches whilst competing and for the presentation of rosettes; dark coloured contrast seats are permitted

**Entries will be via Showing Scene – they will be on a first come, first served basis, and a wait list will be held; if a team is entered and then wishes to withdraw they may do so, up to the closing date with a refund (less admin fee of £10 per team); after the closing date, refunds will only be given if the team can be replaced off the wait list.**

**ENTRIES MAY ONLY BE MADE BY DCs, CENTRE PROPRIETORS or TEAM MANAGERS. Entries will close Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May (earlier if classes are full, when a wait list be will kept).**

Changes/ substitutions will be accepted before 12 noon Saturday 13th June and must be emailed to Jane Ogle ([gogle@btinternet.com](mailto:gogle@btinternet.com)) asap.

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## Rules & Regulations

**PASSPORTS:** horses/ponies will not be allowed to compete without their passport with valid flu vaccinations – DCs/Centre Proprietors will be asked to confirm that your horse's/pony's flu vaccination record is correct and up to date. **Passports will be spot checked for compliance. A horse with a non-compliant passport will NOT be allowed to compete (nor will any horse/pony it has travelled to the venue with on the day) and there will be no refund of entry. Please allow time for passport checking. Please check the Pony Club website for current rules:** See Resources on The Pony Club website.

**NUMBERS:** rider numbers **MUST** be printed out by each competitor – if wearing a number bib please wear front and back. If the number is to be put on the saddlecloth – please do **A5** size and wear both sides. If the number is to be worn on the back of the rider, then please print at least **A5** size. Numbers to be printed/written as large as possible in dark ink please.

**Bridle numbers are NOT to be used anywhere!!**

**Competitors' numbers must be visible when mounted, at all times whilst on the Showground.**

1. Stallions are allowed with prior permission from the Organiser (Jane Ogle); any stallion ridden by a Pony Club member **must** have written permission from their DC/Centre Proprietor which must be sent to Jane Ogle, when the entry has been made. Stallions must wear stallion discs and ribbons and be led with a chain lead rope.

All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on the day of the competition.

Turnout for ALL Pony Club members and horses should be as in the Pony Club Rules for Show-jumping 2026.

2. **SPURS & PADDED BATONS:** ALL spurs worn anywhere on the showground must comply with Pony Club rules. **Only those competitors with a yellow hat tag are allowed to wear spurs.** Only padded batons as specified in the PC Rules 2026 may be used anywhere on the showground. Misuse of spurs/padded batons by any competitor will be recorded and reported and may result in disqualification (for the team) from the competition.

3. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors, or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.

4. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Judges' Box in writing with a £50 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the end of that class.

**5. INSURANCE:** please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for riders, horse, property and third party.

**6. PHOTOGRAPHS:** by entering this competition you agree to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed, please tell the photographer on entering the arena before you jump.

7. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Organisers or Royal Three Counties Show will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property, or other persons.

**8. REFUNDS & WITHDRAWALS:** If a team needs to withdraw before the closing date, a refund will only be given less an admin fee of £10. After the closing date, a withdrawing team will only be refunded if their place can be filled from the Wait List. All refunds will be subject to a £10 admin fee.

## Disclaimers
