JUDGING;

In all classes which have height restrictions any animals that the judges feel exceed the stated

height limit will be asked to leave and come forward again for the appropriate class unless a height

certificate issued by the joint measurement board can be produced.

CHAMPIONSHIPS;

The 1st & 2nd prize winners may come forward for their respective championship, where a champion and reserve will be selected.

The Champion will then come forward at the end of judging (APPROX 2.30pm) for the judging

of the Supreme Championship, where a Supreme & Reserve Ridden and in Hand Champion will be selected.
