Please note: Exhibits MUST be in the Produce Marquee before 8.30am 13/08/2024. Judging will commence at 9am in all sections.

#### Rules

- 1. All entries to be staged before 8.30am on Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> of August 2024 Show.
- 2. No exhibit may be removed from the marquee before 16.30pm and must be removed by 17:30pm.
- 3. The judging will start promptly at 9.00am.
- 4. The Judge's decision will be final.
- 5. Perpetual Cups and Shields to be returned by the end of April. Winners of the cups will be required to sign an undertaking of the responsibility for the, whilst in their possession.
- 6. The Committee's decision will be final on any subject not referred to in these rules.
- 7. Each exhibitor will receive a card giving the number of his / her exhibit in each class. Exhibitors are asked to fill in their details on the revers of this card before judging which must be attached facedown to the exhibit.
- 8. Exhibits must be owned and created by the exhibitor. (This exemption does not apply to exhibitors in the Floral Art section.)
- 9. All competitors must comply with requests made by the STEWARDS.
- 10. Whilst every care will be taken, the COMMITTEE will NOT be responsible for exhibitors or containers lost or damages, whilst at the show. Acceptance of this clause is a condition of entry.
- 11. No exhibits to be removed until after prizegiving.
- 12. Entries not claimed by 6pm on the day of the show will be disposed of.
- 13. The cash prizes will be paid at the end of the show. Prize cards and registration number should be shown to the Treasurer. All efforts should be made to collect your prize money after the show. After which prize money will be regarded as a donation to the society fund.
- 14. SUBSTITUTE JUDGES Should a judge be prevented from fulfilling his engagement for any reason, the Administrator and Superintendent Steward of the relevant section reserve the right to appoint a substitute.
- 15. All Wines should have been made by the exhibitor by the process of fermentation.
- 16. All Spirits should have been made by the exhibitor by the process of infusion.
- 17. Bottles should be plain, clear glass bottles.
- 18. PLAIN WHITE labels only to be used.
- 19. In accordance with the Local Authority Public Health By laws and Regulations NO EXHIBITS in the Dairy Produce or Cookery Section may be sold on the Showground.
- 20. The Honey and/or wax exhibited must be the produce of the exhibitor's own bees.
- 21. Jars containing run or extracted honey must be of the British Standards Institute Specification with a standard commercial screw top.
- 22. The recipe for the Honey Cake is as follows: Honey Cake Round Tin 17cm 18cm (6½ " 7"); 85g (3ozs) Caster Sugar, 113g (4ozs) Margarine, 113g (4ozs) Clear Honey, 170g (6ozs) Plain Flour, 1 level teaspoon Baking Powder, 2 Eggs, 454g (1lb) Mixed Fruit (no cherries), ½ teaspoon Lemon Juice, 2 level teaspoons of Mixed Spice, Milk to mix if necessary. Method: Creaming, Bake in oven 180C (350F) Gas Mark 4. 1hr.45min. 2 hours.
