These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 31st July – 2nd August 2018.

#### **Shetland Society Classes Rules**

- The judge's decision is final
- Exhibitors must be appropriately dressed at all times while in the ring including the wearing of a hat, cap or headscarf, no jeans.
- Whips or canes are not to exceed 30".
- The affiliated classes will run under the rules of the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society (SPSBS).
- All Ponies entered must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society.
- Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot cannot be shown
- Foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the show
- All stallions and colts 2 years and over must be suitably bitted. All 2 year old entire males must wear a stallion/colt disc on their bridle when on the showground and in the ring. Ponies without the bridle markers cannot be judged.
- Children showing colts or stallions in hand must be 14years or over, ridden must be 11 years or over.
- There must be no colts or stallions in young handler classes
- Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages. All PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. The most recent updates to the list are the addition of SNELL E2016 and EN1384 (2017); the newest version of the SNELL Standard could have begun to appear in 2017 and is accepted to the list; the newest version of

the EN1384 Standard will begin to appear during 2018 and is also accepted to the list. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets one of the above standards.

• Ring Etiquette: the Judge must never be spoken to using his/her name. Listen to instructions provided by the Steward or Judge and watch exhibitors in front of you. When asked to walk/trot a pony out, ensure the pony travels with you - do not drag it along. When turning the pony, push it away from you - do not pull it towards you. KNEELING IN FRONT OF PONIES IS NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME. Do not ever leave the ring before the end of the class without first gaining the permission of the Judge, through the Steward. Mobile phones are not permitted under any circumstance.

#### **NPS Rules**

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 31<sup>st</sup> July 2nd August 2018

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

#### **South West Pony Association Championships Qualifying Rules**

This show is a qualifier for the South West Pony Association Championships to be held 30<sup>th</sup> August -2<sup>nd</sup> September 2018,at The David Broome Event Centre, Crick, Gwent..

#### To qualify for the Championships:

- 1. Enter one of the qualifying classes.
- 2. Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card signed in the ring.
- 3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card.
- 4. Return the card to together with any registration fees due within 14 days of this show.

Please Note: Registration fee for 2018 is £30 to include all members of the family and equines owned by the family.
