SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

1 ENTRIES

- a) The Final closing date is 27th May for on line entries after which no entries can be accepted under any circumstances. A ballot will be held should there be too many entries received and Exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible after the closing date should any of their entries be balloted out.
- b) All entries must be accompanied by the appropriate Fees. SUBSTITUTION may be allowed in Jumping Competitions at the discretion of the Executive, provided that a written statement is produced to support the application and the animal substituted is in the same ownership.
- Entries will be limited to a number allowing the starters as shown per Class.
- d) Entries in all classes are restricted to horses registered with British Showjumping and ridden by Members in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79. Junior members competing on horses are only able to do so from the beginning of the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached.
- e) Exhibitors/Riders British Showjumping Membership Numbers MUST be shown on the Remittance Form and Registration Numbers of horses on the Entry Form. FAILURE TO GIVE THESE DETAILS MAY RESULT IN ENTRIES NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

2 DECLARATIONS.

- a) Ardingly Ring Classes The Order of Jumping in all classes, also applying to Jump Offs and as drawn by ballot, MUST be adhered to. Competitors MUST declare their intention of starting at the Declaration Secretary's Office by 1 hour before the advertised time of the relevant class, either in person or by telephone.
- b) Balcombe Ring Classes The first Class each day will be run on a drawn order which will be displayed on the COLLECTING RING BOARD. Declarations MUST be made to the Collecting Ring Steward for all Classes by ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE ADVERTISED STARTING TIME.

3. STANDARD OF JUMPING.

Competitors making more than a certain number of faults in any Class may be asked to retire in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 203.3.

4. PRIZE MONEY.

Prize money will be awarded in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 76.6 and will not be less than NON Members Entry Fee. In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6.

STABLING.

Must be booked on the official stabling form. No application for refund of charges paid can be considered after the 1st June.

6. WALKING THE COURSE.

In Adult Competitions only competitors taking part in that particular class may walk the course. Everyone entering the ring must be correctly dressed.

7. All Prize-Winners are obliged to execute a lap of honour after the prize giving. British Showjumping Rule 82.19. No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury

FIRST AID: is provided by the Show and will be charged at £7.00 per rider per day.

Equine Influenza Vaccinations

Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination and then 2nd vaccination between 21-92 days later), followed by the first booster (150 – 215 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the first booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose.

Horses must have been vaccinated within 6 months before the show but not less than 7 days of arriving at the show.

Foals

In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born.

Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course.

We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times.

Vaccinations are subject to local risk assessments by the attending veterinarians.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NEITHER VACCINATION CERTIFICATES NOR PASSPORTS SHOULD BE SENT TO THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO THE EVENT. HOWEVER, RANDOM CHECKS WILL BE CARRIED OUT ON THE SHOWGROUND DURING THE SHOW.
