#### **INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS**

# **Equine Influenza Update:**

Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses attending Stithians Show. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 – 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old. This Rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the Showing Council and ASAOwebsites. The current FEI ruling is for a six monthly booster as opposed to annual; therefore it is recommended that you check with shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering e.g. Windsor, Hickstead. HOYS etc.

We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times. Vaccinations are subject to local risk assessments by the attending veterinarians. Please note that neither vaccination certificates nor passports should be sent to the show office prior to the event. However, random checks will be carried out on the showground during the show.

This show is affiliated to Sports Horse Breeding of Great Britain (SHB(GB)) and classes 11-14 & 16 are held under their rules. Class 11 must have a valid JMB certificate.

Only horses registered with SHB (GB) and who are also registered on the current year's Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter in Qualifying classes for Ridden and Working Hunter Championships and the Show Hunter Registration Number must be quoted on entry forms. Any horse that is entered for a Qualifying Class without first being in the Show Hunter Register cannot subsequently be registered and therefore will not be eligible for entry in any qualifying classes for the remainder of the season.

Competitors may compete on a day ticket and may have a maximum of two day tickets per season. Each day ticket in valid for one show and it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration/over stamp for that show. If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration/over stamp must be received in the SHB (GB) office within 14 days. Details from www.sportshorsegb.co.uk

SHB(GB) designates certain Shows as qualifying shows for the RIHS at which horses may qualify for the RIHS in the current year or at specific shows for the following year. At these Shows the two highest placed horses in the Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Small Classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. In the Working Hunter class the three highest placed horses will qualify. No horse lower than third will qualify. If there is a Working Hunter Championship made up of the first and second prize winners from the light and heavyweight working hunter classes respectively, these four horses will qualify for RIHS unless they have already done so. Judges must place all horses to determine qualifiers.

**This show is a qualifier for Equifest 2020.** The two highest placed exhibits, not already qualified, in **Classes 1-4, 11-14, 16-33, 35-39, 47-57, 59-62** will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Show ground on the 19<sup>th</sup> August – 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2020.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Horse Association (BSHA) and Class 15 is held under their rules. Exhibitors wishing to enter Class 15 who are not registered with The British Show Horse Association can purchase a day ticket – details from <a href="https://www.britishshowhorse.org">www.britishshowhorse.org</a> Horses registered with the Association must be owned, exhibited and ridden by current BSHA members. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form. Day Tickets. Non-members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Working Show Horse Class 15. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form from the BSHA website.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Affiliation No: BSPS 120/19

This show is a qualifier for the 2020 BSPS Championships Show, to be held 26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> August 2020 at Arena UK. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners only in classes 55 & 56 will qualify and the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize winners only in classes 61 & 62 will qualify for the Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with rules 21 & 26 of the BSPS 2020 rule book and ridden by a BSPS member. 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> prize winners in classes 59 & 60 will qualify for the Champions Show.

**This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Blue Riband Pony of the Year.** The 1st & 2nd prize winners in **Classes 60** & **62** will qualify provided the pony is owned, registered and ridden by a BSPS member.

**This show is a qualifier for The BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions.** 1st prize winners in Classes 56, 57, 59 & 62 will qualify.

**This show is a qualifier for the BSPS "Classic Services Group" Challenge.** Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any B.S.P.S. affiliated show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2020 Horse of the Year Show. If a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the Classic Services Group Challenge.

**This show is a qualifier for the BSPS "Black Country Saddles" Best Rider of the Year.** The Best Rider in **classes 55-57 & 59-62** will receive a card and qualify for the final at the BSPS 2020 Summer Championships Show provided the pony is owned, registered and ridden by a BSPS member.

This show is a qualifier for the NPS Area 26 End of Season Extravaganza 2020, to be held at Tall Trees Arena on Saturday 14<sup>h</sup> September 2020. The top three competitors in classes 1-4, 7, 8, 11-14, 21-33, 35-62 will qualify.

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society (NPS). Classes 21-33 are qualifiers for the NPS Summer Championship Show (31st July to 2nd August 2020) to be held at the Three Counties Showground, Malvern. These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Exhibits in these classes must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books and foals in class 20 must be eligible for registration in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 31st July to 2nd August 2020. The highest placed pony, if owned by NPS Qualifying or Life members, in each class qualifies for the final. Qualification may pass down to third in the event 1st and 2nd have qualified. Owner's membership cards to be shown in the ring.

**Classes 47, 49 & 50** are qualifiers for the NPS Area 10 Show Pony In Hand Supreme National Championship & NPS Menedh Stud Show Hunter Pony In Hand National Championship. Both the highest placed Show Pony and the highest placed Show Hunter Pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may be passed down to 3<sup>rd</sup> place if the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed ponies have already qualified.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 31st July to 2nd August 2020.

This show is affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association (BSPA). Classes 33-37 are open to Skewbald and Piebald Horses/Ponies only. Classes 35-39 & 51-54 are qualifiers for the BSPA World Championships of Colour National Championship Show to be held at The College EC, Keysoe, Beds, in September 2020.

**This show is affiliated to The Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society** and "Best Shetland" rosettes will be awarded in **classes 21, 23, 24 & 25** providing the exhibit is registered with the society.

Exhibits in Classes 45 & 46 must be fully paid up members of the International Miniature Horse and Pony Society Ltd (IMHPS) Horses registered with IMHPS and placed 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> in both classes qualify for the Miniature Horse of the Year Show to be held in October 2020 at Keysoe College, Bedford.

This show is a qualifier for TSR Riders Championships. This show is a qualifier for the 2020 TSR Riders Regional Championships. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You do not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The rider qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals! TSR Riders Champs  $-1^{\rm st}$  and  $2^{\rm nd}$  places qualify in classes will receive a qualification card in the ring. Any exhibitor wishing to enter a protest must do so in writing to the Secretary, accompanied by a deposit of £20. If the protest is not sustained, the deposit may be forfeited. If the protest is upheld and any award winner becomes disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding award will take the award of the disqualified winner and the lowest award shall go to the reserve award. No protest can be accepted after the conclusion of the Show, nor will any protest be accepted until all the horses in the particular class have left the ring. This does not affect the protest procedures for affiliated classes

#### CLASS 3 NUPAFEED/EQUIFEST RIDING HORSE & HIGHTOPPS STUD/EQUIFEST HACK

Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Exceeding 148cms; Rider any age. This class is a qualifier for Equifest 2020 for both small & large Riding Horse and Hacks, TSR Rider Championship & NPS Area 26 Extravaganza.

Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Riders to have attained their 3rd birthday but not their 8th birthday by the 1/1/20; Snaffle bridles must be worn with the leading rein attached to the noseband. This class is a qualifier for NPS Area 26 Extravaganza.

The youngest rider to receive the W.D. Uren Perpetual Trophy.

## CLASS 8 FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Riders to have attained their 7th birthday but not their 12th birthday by 1/1/20; No leading reins; Any suitable bridle. *This class is a qualifier for NPS Area 26 Extravaganza*.

#### CLASS 9 YOUNG RIDER

Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Riders to have attained their 12th birthday but not their 16th birthday by 1/1/20; Any suitable bridle.

The winner to receive the Somar International Perpetual Shield.

#### **BEST RIDER CHAMPIONSHIP**

Two riders each from classes 7-9 will be nominated to come forward for the Championship.

The Dingle Silver Perpetual Challenge Cup will be presented to the Best Rider

#### CLASS 10 OPEN

A horse, which is registered as a Small Hunter, cannot compete in an Open Weight Class. When registering on the current Show Hunter Register, a current Joint Measurement Board Height Certificate must be forwarded with the application. Judges are not empowered to question the height of a Registered Small Hunter. Owners & Riders & Horses must be affiliated to Sport Horse Breeding (GB). Day Ticket = £36 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 1 show in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. To be run under SHB(GB) 2020 Rules. This class is a qualifier for B Crabtree Agi Services/Equifest Ridden Small Hunter Championship 2020, TSR Rider Championship & NPS Area 26 Extravaganza.

The winner to receive the perpetual Stroll-On salver.

# CLASS 12 R.I.H.S. (2021) OPEN LIGHTWEIGHT HUNTER

Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Capable of carrying up to 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs); Owners, Riders & Horses must be affiliated to Sport Horse Breeding (GB). Day Ticket = £36 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 1 show in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. To be run under SHB(GB) 2020 Rules. This class is a qualifier for Black Country Saddles / Equifest Ridden Hunters Championship 2020, TSR Rider Championship & NPS Area 26 Extravaganza.

# CLASS 13 R.I.H.S. (2021) OPEN MIDDLEWEIGHT HUNTER

Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Capable of carrying 79.5kgs (12stone 7lbs) and not exceeding 89kgs (14 stone); Owners, Riders & Horses must be affiliated to Sport Horse Breeding (GB). Day Ticket = £36 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 1 show in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. To be run under SHB(GB) 2020 Rules. This class is a qualifier for Black Country Saddles/Equifest Ridden.

# CLASS 14 R.I.H.S. (2021) OPEN HEAVYWEIGHT HUNTER

Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Capable of carrying over 89kgs (14 stone); Owners, Riders & Horses must be affiliated to Sport Horse Breeding (GB) Day **Ticket = £36** (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 1 show in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. To be run under SHB(GB) 2020 Rules. This class is a qualifier for Black Country Saddles / Equifest Ridden Hunters Championship 2020, TSR Rider Championship & NPS Area 26 Extravaganza.

Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Owners, Riders & Horses must be affiliated to Sport Horse Breeding (GB) **Day Ticket = £36** (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 1 show in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. To be run under SHB(GB) 2020 Rules. Mare, Gelding or Stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail) Exceeding 148cm. Rider any age except for stallions when the rider must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1/1/19. Maximum height of fences 1.14 metre at the discretion of the Judges. TSR Rider Championship Qualifier & The Stokes Family/Equifest Open WH Championship 2020.
