RIDDEN CLASSES

HORSES

Judge: Katie Jerram-Hunnable (Essex)

- 1. Ridden Cob Lightweight, Heavyweight or Maxi Cob; Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Rider any age
- 2. Riding Horse/Hack Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Exceeding 148cms.
- 3. Ridden Hunter Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Exceeding 143cms
- 4. Ridden Small Hunter Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Exceeding 148 cm (14.2hh approx) but not exceeding 158 cm (15.2hh approx).

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 1-4

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Judge: Frankie Currell (Wales)

- 5. Lead Rein Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B; Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Not exceeding 122 cm; Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year; To be shown in a snaffle bit.
- 6. First Ridden Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B; Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Not exceeding 128 cm; Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

M&M MINI CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 5&6

- 7. Welsh A&B Open to registered pure bred Stallions, Mares and Geldings; Five years old and over; Rider any age except stallions (see NPS Rule Book); No Leading Rein combinations. This class may be amalgamated with Class 8 if entry numbers are low
- 8. Dartmoor/Exmoor/Shetland Open to registered pure bred Stallions, Mares and Geldings; Five years old and over.; Rider any age except stallions (see NPS Rule Book); No Leading Rein combinations. This class may be amalgamated with Class 7 if entry numbers are low.

- 9. Welsh C&D Open to registered pure bred Stallions, Mares and Geldings; Five years old and over; Rider any age. This class may be amalgamated with Class 10 & 11 if entry numbers are low.
- 10. Dales Fell & Highland Open to registered pure bred Stallions, Mares and Geldings; Five years old and over; Rider any age. This class may be amalgamated with Class 9 & 11 if entry numbers are low.
- 11. New Forest & Connemara Open to registered pure bred Stallions, Mares and Geldings; Five years old and over; Rider any age. This class may be amalgamated with Class 9 & 10 if entry numbers are low.

SHOW PONIES & SHOW HUNTER PONIES

- 12. Lead Rein SP/SHP Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony; Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over; Not exceeding 122cms; Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 13. First Ridden SP/SHP Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony; Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Not exceeding 122cms; Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 14. Open SP/SHP Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony; Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Not exceeding 148cms; Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

RIDDEN PONY CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 12-14

COLOURED

- 15. Ridden Coloured, Plaited Open to 4 years old or over, exceeding 153cms. All riders must be 15 years or older as from the 1st January in this current year.
- 16. Ridden Coloured, Native/Traditional 4 years old and over.

RIDDEN COLOURED CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 15 & 16.

HEAVY HORSES

17. Ridden Heavy Horse – 4 years old and over; To include registered and un-registered horses.

WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

Entries to our working hunter pony classes will need to be filmed over our working hunter course in the main ring at the Stithians Showground which will be available to hire on Sunday 6th June and Saturday 12th June. Book your slot at www.ShowingScene.com.

- 20. 90cm Open to plaited or native ponies; Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over; Fences not to exceed 90cms.
- 21. 80cm Open to plaited or native ponies; Stallion, Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Fences not to exceed 80cms.
- 22. 70cm Open to plaited or native ponies; Stallion, Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Fences not to exceed 70cms.
- 23. 60cm Open to plaited or native ponies; Stallion, Mare or Gelding; 4 years old and over; Fences not to exceed 60cms.
- 24. Cradle Stakes Open to plaited or native ponies; Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over; Fences not to exceed 40cms. Riders must not have attainted their 12th birthday by the 1st January 2021. May be led.

- 34. Yearling Colt, Gelding or Filly foaled in 2020, not to exceed 158cm at maturity.
- 35. 2&3 yrs Colt, Gelding or Filly foaled in 2018 or 2019, not to exceed 158cm at maturity.
- 36. 4yrs & over Stallion, Gelding or Mare, not to exceed 158cm.

PONY BREEDING CHAMPIONSHIP

37. Yearling - Colt, Gelding or Filly foaled in 2020.

How to enter ...

Each exhibit requires two photographs and a video to be submitted.

Ridden Classes: Each entry will require one photograph taken from the side of the horse/pony, one photograph taken from the front of the horse/pony and a short video of an individual show - to include a walk, trot, canter and a change of rein; an extension is optional. For first ridden classes, canter is optional and a gallop must not be included. For lead rein classes, ponies may only walk and trot.

Working Hunter Classes: We will be hosting a course at Stithians Showground which will need to be hired to enter our workers classes. The course can be hired in 30 minute slots and during this time you'll need to have a round filmed for submission to the competition. You can film as many times as you wish. Two photographs will also need to be submitted. To book the your hire of the course, visit www.ShowingScene.com.

In-hand Classes: Each entry will require one photograph taken from the side of the horse/pony, one photograph taken from the front of the horse/pony and a short video of an individual show to include a walk away from the camera, trot back towards the camera and a trot viewed from the side.

Driving Classes: Each entry will require one photograph taken from the side of the turnout and one photograph taken from in front of the turnout and a short video of an individual to include walk, trot, a change of rein and a rein back.

Entries are to be made via www.ShowingScene.com.

The judges will be able to remotely log into the website in order to view your photographs and videos after the closing date and place them accordingly. All entries will be anonymous to the judge.

Closing Date: 12 noon, Friday 16th June 2021.

Late entries will not be accepted.

Please enter well in advance in case of any technical difficulties in uploading your entries.

Rules

Entry to the show is at your own risk, we cannot be held responsible for your participation in this event. It is your responsibility to ensure the safety of your handlers, riders and horses/ponies.

- 1. All photographs and videos must have been taken on or after 1st May 2021.
- 2. No professional photography or videography
- 3. All videos must be filmed in landscape.
- 4. Once the entries for this event have closed, substitutions or alterations to submitted footage will not be accepted.
- 5. Ridden & driven ponies must be 4 years old or over.
- 6. Properly fastened BSI standard riding hats must always be worn when mounted and for handlers under the age of 14.
- 7. Ponies under the age of 2 must not be bitted.
- 8. Photos and videos may not be edited at all.
- 9. There should be no writing included in any videos and no talking to the camera.
- 10. The welfare of horses & ponies is paramount and no lame, sick or overly fat or underweight ponies should be exhibited.
- 11. Video submissions will be used to create spectator videos. Photographs and videos may also be used for promotional purposes. Should you not wish for your submissions to be included please email horses@stithians.show.

Photographs, videos, names and results information may be published in the Association's publications (online & printed) and may also be forwarded to breed societies and media outlets as part of the show's publicity of the event. The making of an entry is irrevocable consent for the storage and disclosure of information in this way.
