BSPS MINI RIDING PONIES - LEAD REIN AND FIRST RIDDEN

Lead rein - no child under the age of 3 years may compete. In lead rein classes the leader must be 16 years old or over and may only lead one pony in a class. In all Leading Rein classes the rein MUST go directly from the bit to the riders hand, with no extra aid or attachment to or on the saddle. The reins must be a normal length and not knotted together or stitched together at a shorter length. Handles on saddles are permitted but the reins must not be attached to the handle or the saddle. The attendant must affix the lead rein to the NOSEBAND on which it must remain

RULES FOR COMPETITORS

In all Pony and Coloured Performance Classes competitors may use any suitable bridles, including Micklem bridles, flash or grakle nosebands and a correctly fitted running martingale. Coloured or plain browbands can be used depending on the type of pony/horse being shown. In the Performance Pony Classes and the non-Native Coloured Horse or Pony Class animals must be plaited. In the Coloured Native/Cob. Traditional Class animals will be shown unplaited or hogged.
