NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival, 25th April 2026. The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details). In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2025/2026 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2026 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part Breds are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 4th – 6th August 2026.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/WTJ Insurance Brokers Ltd Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in August 2026.

RULES

- 1. The Organisers and Show's officers, servants or agents shall not be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage from any cause or circumstances whatever to exhibitors or their servants or agents or other members of the public, to any animal or property or any vehicle or otherwise brought onto the showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show or while entering or leaving the same or otherwise for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Show.
- 2. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the Judge's panel and order of classes if it should become necessary.
- 3. The Committee reserves the right to cancel/amalgamate any class with less than 3 entries
- 4. The Committee reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fees in the event of the show being cancelled.
- 4. Any of this the committee shall try to do their best to notify competitors through social media and online however it is up to competitors to check through these ways of communication for any of these notifications.
- 5. Substitutions and nomination of entries are not allowed once the entry closing date has passed
- 6. Refund of entry fee only on receipt of a veterinary certificate.
- 7. The judge's decision is final.
- 8. Any protest/objection must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary within half an hour of the incident together with a deposit of £10. If the protest is not upheld, the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the show.
- 9. Except for the Part-Bred classes, all entries must be entered in the main section of the stud book for their respective breeds. Part Bred ponies must be registered in the Welsh Part-Bred register.
- 10. Entries in the WPCS Section X of the Stud Book Foundation Stock cannot compete but FS.1 and FS.2 may.
- 11. All stud book registration numbers must be given on all entry forms.
- 12. Non readable or uncompleted entry forms may cause your entry not being taken. Please take care when filling out forms.
- 13. HATS Must be worn at all times when RIDING OF ANY AGE & HANDLING if NOT attained your 14th BIRTHDAY before 1st January of the current Year. Correctly secured and fitted Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 and 2023, SNELL E2016 and E2021 onwards, AS/NZS 3838 2006
- 14. Handlers who have NOT attained their 14th birthday on the 1st January · MUST wear a HARD HAT of current Safety Standards, Gloves, and suitable footwear, in all handler classes. · If competing in OPEN IN HAND CLASSES must ONLY show Geldings or Barren Mares. · No Handlers under the age of 5 years. · NO Colt, Stallions or Mares and Foals can enter Young Handler classes.
- 15. COLTS AND STALLIONS · All Colts and Stallions from the age of 1yr must wear a Stallion bridle badge. · All Colts (2years old and over) and stallions must be bitted · Stallions or Colts of a certain age must be licensed as per their Breed Society Standards. · Must be, led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday on the 1st January.
- 16. Riders of · Welsh Section A & B Stallion must have attained their 12th Birthday · Welsh Section C & D Stallions must have attained their 14th Birthday
- 17. No cane or whips to be more than 30 inches · Excessive use of a whip anywhere on a showground will result in disqualification of the horse and rider/handler from any classes entered on that day. · This includes but not limited to; Use of the whip to vent a competitor's anger is always excessive. Use of the whip which causes injury, e.g. broken skin or weal is always excessive. Use after elimination or retirement is always excessive. Using a whip from the ground after a fall or dismount is always excessive. If the rider's arm comes above the shoulder when using the whip this is always excessive. The wearing of spurs or dummy spurs in ALL classes held forbidden
- 18. NO MANES OR TAILS TO BE PLAITED IN ANY M&M CLASSES, OPTIONAL FOR PART-BREDS
- 19. In accordance with WPCS showing rules animals 3 years old and under including foals must not be body clipped for showing purposes. Long hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible. Whiskers must not be trimmed. Following the FEI General Assembly held on 23November 2020, a new rule that prohibits the clipping/shaving of sensory hairs was passed as part of the veterinary regulations. This has been implemented on welfare grounds.
- 20. If mane and tail are very thick, they can be discreetly thinned, Tails: should look natural and should not be levelled off (banged).
- 21. Ponies must be the bona fide property of the registered owner on the Passport or officially leased.
- 22. Competitors are reminded that they should have a valid passport with up-to-date ownership and vaccination record accompanying the pony Just in case of spot inspection by the event officials or DEFRA
- 23. Geldings not holding the correct status will be allowed 14 days from the date of the show to provide the Society with the passport including the fully completed castration section for updating to Gelding. Those not updated within 14 days will not be eligible for a Society medal (subject to meeting the criteria).
- 24. Exhibitors are requested not to bring any coughing/infectious pony to the show and may be requested to remove any such animal
- 25. No change of handler may be made once a class has commenced without the permission of the judge
- 26. Competitors entering classes which may clash do so at their own risk, no entry fees will be refunded. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure they are ready to enter the ring at the appropriate time.
- 27. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
- 28. Exhibitors must not enter an animal when that animal will be judged by a person who has or has had a financial interest in the animal, stud fee excluded, (the exhibitor being the owner, lessee or person producing and/or showing the animal). Judges may not adjudicate a pony which, to the judge's knowledge, is a pony bred, sold, leased, or produced by the judge or his immediate family or employer.
- 29. All cups and trophies remain the property of the South Western Association of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society and must be returned to the show secretary. All cups and trophies are the responsibility of the winner whilst in their possession. They may only be signed for by an adult. Any person who has had an SWA cup or trophy in the past and has not returned it by the time of the next show may not be allowed to take away a cup or trophy they have been awarded.
