Number	Name	Description
1	Leading Rein.	Lead Rein. Rider must have attained their 3rd birthday by the day of the show and not to have attained their 9th birthday on 1st January 2023. Ponies must be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle with the reins going directly from the bit to the riders hands. The lead rein must be attached to the noseband only. SPSBS Rosette to 1st placed The Equine Dresser Bridle Bag to the 1st placed 1st and 2nd placed qualify for the Ridden Championship which will take place directly after Class 2 - First Ridden.
2	First Ridden	Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday on 1st January 2023. Ponies can be shown in any suitable bridle. Ponies must not be cantered except in individual show. SPSBS Rosette to 1st placed The Equine Dresser Bridle bag to the 1st placed. 1st and 2nd placed will qualify for the Ridden Championship which will be directly after the conclusion of this class.
4	Newcomers	Standard Shetland Pony Owners not to have owned or bred Shetland ponies for more than 3 years. Ponies any age or gender.
3	Young Handler	Young Handler. 15 yrs and under. SPSBS Rosette to 1st placed - Special rosette for under 8 yrs
5	Standard Intermediate	4 - 6yrs of age, any gender. Ponies may compete any other applicable classes.
6	Standard Novice Pony	Any age or gender. Not to have been placed 1st up to date of entry closing date.
7	Standard Yearling colt or filly	Class will be split if sufficient entries.
8	Standard two year old Colt or Filly	Rosette for the best opposite sex to winner
9	Three year old Standard Colt or Filly	Standard Three year old Colt or Filly. Rosette for the best opposite sex to winner
10	Standard Brood Mare with Foal at foot	Foal to be more than three weeks old. Best Foal to compete in the Junior & Foal Championship
11	Junior Standard Gelding	Three years old and under. 1st and 2nd to compete in the Gelding and Junior Championships
12	Standard Gelding four years and over	Four years and over. 1st and 2nd to compete for the Gelding Championship
13	Standard Yeld Mare	Four years old and over without foal at foot.
14	Standard Stallions	Stallions four years and over. Stallions are advised to wear Stallion disks on bridle.

15	Exhibitor bred Miniature - Standard	Miniature or Standard bred by exhibitor, any age, any gender.
CH1	Ridden Championship	Ridden Championship 1st & 2nd in classes 1 & 2 to come forward to compete for Ridden and Reserve Champions.
CH2	Junior Standard Championship	1st & 2nd in Classes 7 to 11 including Foal in Class 10 to come forward to compete for Standard Junior Champion and Reserve
CH5	Standard Senior Championship	1st & 2nd from Classes 5 - 12 to 15 to come forward for Senior and Reserve Championship
CH6	Overall Standard Championship	Junior - Gelding - Senior Champions and Reserves to come forward for Overall Standard Championship.

16	Newcomers	Miniature Shetland Pony. Owners not to have owned or bred Standard or Miniature Shetland ponies for more than 3 years. Ponies any age or gender.
17	Intermediate Miniature	Intermediate Miniature 4 - 6yrs of age, any gender. Ponies may compete any other applicable classes.
18	Novice Miniature	Novice Miniature Pony. Any age or gender. Not to have been placed 1st up to date of entry closing date.
19	Miniature Yearling Colt or Filly	The class will be split if sufficient entries. G.E.M.S Rosette to the highest placed GEMS Member wearing a 2023 Badge.
20	Miniature Two year old Colt or Filly	Miniature Two year old Colt or Filly Rosette for best opposite sex to winner. G.E.M.S Rosette to the highest placed GEMS Member wearing a 2023 Badge.
21	Miniature Three year old Colt or Filly	Miniature Three year old Colt or Filly. Rosette for the best opposite sex to the winner. G.E.M.S Rosette to the highest placed GEMS Member wearing a 2023 Badge.
22	Miniature Brood Mare with foal at foot.	Miniature Brood mare with foal at foot. Foal to be more than three weeks old. Best Foal to compete in the Junior & Foal Championship. G.E.M.S Rosette to the highest placed GEMS Member wearing a 2023 Badge.
23	Junior Miniature Gelding	Miniature Gelding three years and under. 1st & 2nd to compete in the Junior and Gelding Championships.
24	Miniature Gelding	Miniature Gelding four years and over. 1st & 2nd to compete in the Gelding and Senior Championships
25	Miniature Yeld mare	Miniature Yeld Mare. Four years old and over without foal at foot. G.E.M.S Rosette to the highest placed GEMS Member wearing a 2023 Badge.
26	Miniature Stallion.	Miniature Stallion, four years old and over. Stallions are advised to wear a stallion disk on their bridle. G.E.M.S Rosette to the highest placed GEMS Member wearing a 2023 Badge.
27	Open Broken Cloured.	Open Broken Coloured Standard or Miniature. Any age or gender.
28	Open Solid Colour	Open Solid Colour (NOT Black) Standard or Miniature Any age or gender.
29	Open Black	Open Black Standard or Miniature Any age or gender.
30	Progeny	This class is open to groups of three ponies of any age, height or gender, to have been forward in classes 1 – 29. Junior ponies maybe entered in one group only. a) Three ponies by the same stallion b) Three ponies out of the same mare c) Stallion and two of his progeny d) Mare and two of her progeny
CH3	Standard & Miniature Gelding Championship	1st & 2nd to come forward from Classes 11 - 12 - 23 - 24 for Overall Gelding Championship & Reserve.

CH4	Foal Championship	Best Standard & Miniature Foal from Classes 10 & 22 to come forward for Foal Champion and Reserve
CH7	Junior Miniature Championship	1st & 2nd in Classes 19 to 23 including Foals to come forward for the Junior Miniature Championship and Reserve
CH9	Senior Miniature Championship	1st & 2nd from classes 17 - 22 - 24 - 25 - 26 to come forward for the Senior Miniature Champion and Reserve Champion
CH8	Broken Coloured Championship	1st & 2nd Standard & Miniature Broken Coloured pony, from any class, to come forward for the Broken Coloured Champion & Reserve.
CH10	Overall Miniature Championship	Junior - Gelding - and Senior Champion and Reserves to come forward.
CH11	The Roger Jones Memorial Supreme Championship	Overall Miniature - Overall Standard and Ridden Champions and Reserves to come forward
