## FLORAL ART COMPETITION

### STAGING AND GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. **All classes are open, regardless of whether you belong to a flower club or not.**  
Class 10 is open to anyone who has never won a **FIRST PRIZE** at any National, Area or County Show judged under NAFAS rules.

CLASSES MAY BE SPONSORED WITH THE EXCEPTION OF 5, 6 & 8. THE SPONSOR'S DETAILS MAY BE DISPLAYED ON A CARD NO LARGER THAN 15cm X 10cm.  
(THE SPONSOR'S CARD WILL NOT BE JUDGED AS PART OF THE EXHIBIT)

2. All exhibits to be judged in accordance with **NAFAS Competition Manual Fourth Edition 2023.**  
The judge's decision is final.

3. Entries will be via an online system on the Lincolnshire Show website

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

**CLOSING DATE: Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2025**

4. In all Classes a limit will be set and entries will close as soon as that limit is reached. The Society reserves the right to limit, refuse or cancel entries.
5. An empty space spoils the Show, so please do not enter more Classes than can be attempted. Exhibitors unable to attend should inform the Show Co-ordinators as soon as possible.
7. The Competition will be staged in a marquee. **STAGING WILL COMMENCE ON TUESDAY 17<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2025 AT 10.00AM AND MUST BE COMPLETED BY 8.00PM** when the marquee will be closed until completion of judging.

All entries must be the unaided work of the competitor and must be assembled in the venue, with the exception of Classes 5, 6 and 8.

Juniors' exhibits may be ready assembled and brought in by a representative.

8. Staging will be provided for all classes. All backgrounds will be white unless stated otherwise. Exhibits staged on continuous tabling, height 80cm from ground level, will be viewed and judged from the front, unless stated otherwise.  
**All measurements are approximate.**

9. The name and address of the exhibitor must be securely attached to the base of all containers etc. Exhibits will remain the sole risk of the competitor. The Lincolnshire Agricultural Society will not be liable for loss or damage from any cause whatsoever. It is advised that any valuable accessories should be removed from the marquee on Thursday at 5.00pm, when dismantling begins.
10. Trophy winners may wish to pay to have their trophies engraved with year, name and club.
11. **NATURAL PLANT MATERIAL TO PREDOMINATE IN ALL CLASSES.**  
  
**The inclusion of artificial plant material (including artificial grass) is not permitted.**  
  
**Please be aware of the humidity in the Marquee which may affect some materials.**
12. To ensure the protection of the exhibits, competitors are requested to offer to steward if at all possible.
13. Competitors will each receive 2 free Show entry tickets.
14. The marquee will be open for public viewing from **approximately**  
10.30am to 6.00pm Wednesday 18th June 2025  
9.00am to 5.00pm Thursday 19th June 2025  
**Please note that the marquee will NOT open until judging is completed.**

An Exhibit  
Space allowed: Width 120cm, Depth 120cm, Height Unlimited.  
Staging – A marked area on grass.  
STAGED BY 1 or 2 NAMED PERSONS Maximum 6 entries
  
2. **EXPECTATION**  
An Abstract Exhibit.  
Space allowed: Width 75cm, Depth 75cm, Height and drop - optional.  
Staging – A Grey Plinth - *Dimensions of plinth width 25cm, depth 25cm, height 100cm*  
Plinth placed centrally in space allowed and may not be moved.  
Viewed and judged all round. Maximum 6 entries
  
3. **FARMYARD RELIC**  
An Exhibit  
Space allowed: 106cm Diameter, Height optional  
Staging - A 106cm diameter, black painted circular base placed directly on grass.  
Viewed all round and judged from the front. Maximum 6 entries
  
4. **THE ESSENCE OF 1869**  
An Exhibit  
Space allowed: Width 75cm, Depth 75cm, Height 98cm  
Staging – Continuous tabling covered in black fabric with a black background  
Maximum 6 entries
  
5. **AERIAL VIEW**  
A Pavé Exhibit.  
Space allowed: Width 60cm, Depth 60cm, Height 20cm  
Staging - Continuous tabling 20cm from the ground covered in black fabric.  
Viewed and judged from above  
**May be brought ready assembled** Maximum 15 entries
  
6. **SHOW WEDNESDAY**  
A Craft Exhibit in the form of a **HAT OR FASCINATOR**.  
Space allowed: Width 60cm, Depth 75cm, Height Optional.  
Staging – Open continuous tabling covered in black fabric.  
Viewed all round and judged from the front.  
Competitor to provide own display stand/head.  
**May be brought in ready assembled.** Maximum 12 entries

 An Exhibit.  
 Space allowed: Width 75cm, Depth 75cm, Height optional.  
 Staging –Continuous tabling covered in beige fabric      Maximum 12 entries
8. **DOUBLE PLATINUM**  
 A Miniature Exhibit.  
 Space allowed: Width 10cm, Depth 10cm, Height 15cm.  
 Staging - Tiered black painted stand with each space allowed marked.  
**Exhibits may be brought in ready assembled.**      Maximum 12 entries
9. **LINCOLNSHIRE LIFE — NOVICE CLASS**  
 An Exhibit.  
 Space allowed: Width 75cm, Depth 75cm, Height optional.  
 Staging –Continuous tabling covered in beige fabric.  
**Open only to those who have never won a first prize at any National, Area or County Show.**      Maximum 10 entries

 A Still Life Exhibit.  
 Space allowed Width 75cm, Depth 75cm, Height 98cm  
 Staging – Continuous tabling covered in black fabric      Maximum 8 entries
11. **TRUE YELLERBELLY!**  
 An Exhibit  
 Space allowed: Width 75cm, Depth 75cm, Height 98cm  
 Staging – Continuous tabling covered in black fabric with a black background  
 Maximum 6 entries
- 12a **FARM LIFE** - Open Class for Juniors, aged up to 12 years  
 An Exhibit  
 Space allowed: Width 38cm, Depth 38cm, Height optional  
 Staging – Continuous tabling covered in beige fabric.

 An Exhibit
