LINCOLNSHIRE SHOW SHEEP PRIZE SCHEDULE

Lincolnshire Agricultural Society's County Parish Holding Number is 24/654/8003

Sheep Entries will be accepted on the following basis:

- The Advanced Closing Date for entries is Monday 27th April 2026. Any entries after this date to carry a premium of £1 per entry to Final Closing Date Monday 17th May 2026. Entries in all sections will be subject to limitations on availability of pens
- Each animal may only be entered for one Sheep Class, however, this animal may then go into a Group Class, (entries for this must be made in advance of the Show). All entries are of course eligible for Special and Championship Classes which may be offered
- A limited number of MV sheep pens 6' x 4' and Non-MV Sheep Pens 6' x 4' will be available at the Show and allocated on a first come, first served basis
- Covered accommodation will be provided for all SHEEP. MV Accredited and Non-MV Accredited Scheme sheep will be housed in separate open sided marquees and have separate judging rings

Please Note For SHEEP of MV Accredited status:

A COPY of the green certificate, listing details of the animals entered must accompany your animals to the Show. This COPY to be presented on arrival at Gate 3 to the Animal Movements Officer.
