Accommodation		<p>Accommodation is very limited and can only be booked when making entries.</p> <p>Twin bedded rooms in the cattle buildings are available for CATTLE exhibitors in the first instance. After the entry close date for Dairy Cattle any available rooms may be offered to other stock exhibitors.</p> <p>Beds or rooms are booked for the period of show. Those booking an individual bed WILL share a room.</p>

Camping

For all exhibitors staying on the showground other than in Stock Exhibitor Rooms.

Does not admit the driver who must hold a day ticket or wristband.

Caravans etc can be delivered to the showground prior to the Show from Monday. Arrivals before this date will be refused entry. Access to the showground will be via the Main Gate and a valid Stock Exhibitor Camping pass will be required. The vehicle will be escorted to the Exhibitor Camping area.

Vehicles not displaying a valid Exhibitors' Camping Area will be directed to the public car parks. Valid admission tickets will be required to gain access from the public car parks into the showground each day.

Wristbands/tickets will be scanned into the showground from the campsite daily.
