ABOUT THE SHOW

Trawden Agricultural Show – Sunday 10th August 2025 – Trawden Recreational Ground, Trawden, Lancashire, BB8 8RR

TICKETING

All exhibitors will be required to have an e-ticket or wristband to gain entry to the show field. Adult exhibitors will receive two exhibitor's e-ticket to the showground for the first Light Horse entry, and an additional exhibitors ticket up to a maximum of 4 tickets. Additional prepaid e-tickets can be purchased at the time of class entry at £10 for adults (£14 on gate) and £6 for children aged 6 and over (£6 on gate). Children under 6 are admitted free of charge and do not require a ticket. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to bring a valid e-ticket or wristband with them on the day.

GENERAL REMARKS AND STRIPULATIONS

Exhibitors are responsible for complying with all regulations from all statutory bodies including all movement licenses and restrictions.

Throughout the duration of the show Stanley House Vets, Colne are the Society's on duty vets, should any horse require emergency care by our named Vets, the exhibitor of that animal will be expected to cover this cost. Exhibitors enter the show field at their own risk.

The Trawden and District Agricultural Society and its members, secretary and directors accept no responsibility for any losses incurred on the show field. Exhibitors must have Public Liability Insurance which covers which covers them when away from the holding.

We also reserve the right to cancel any classes or indeed the show, should abandonment be necessary. Refunds will not be made.

Should your vehicle/s and/or equipment require towing onto/ from the show field in the event of inclement weather, the trustees, organising committee, nor any of their servants, be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage sustained by the applicants, their property, or their assistants. The Society accepts no liability whatsoever and should the applicant not agree to the terms then they will be left to organise their own entrance/exit onto the show field, except in the event that your vehicle is causing an obstruction to other traffic or a show entrance or exit and cannot be moved by you within a very short time frame to allow the free flow of traffic again. In these circumstances the society will be permitted to move the vehicle by whatever means necessary and subject to causing as little damage as possible to the vehicle but will accept no liability for any damage as a result of the same.

RULES & REGULATIONS

All Exhibitors who enter shall be considered to have read the following Rules & Regulations as laid down by the Show Committee. Anything not covered but brought into question will be decided by the relevant authority. The decision of the Show Chairman & Committee will be final.

1. Entries must be lodged in a proper manner on the enclosed form, signed by the Exhibitor or an authorized agent, and complying in full with these Regulations and any other conditions as may be specified in the current Rule books of Societies to which this Show has affiliated.
2. Animals must be entered under the name by which they are registered with their Breed Society (if applicable) and the name of the Owner(s) must be stated if different from the Exhibitor.
3. The appropriate Entry Fee **MUST** accompany the entry and must be received by the Closing Date. Entry Fees will only be refunded on receipt of a Veterinary Certificate. £5.00 will be retained from cancelled entries for administration charges. Entries will not be accepted by telephone – **POSTAL ENTRIES** or **ENTRIES ONLINE** at www.trawdenshow.co.uk. Changes to Entries must be received in writing before the Closing Date.
4. The Society reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry already accepted without any reason for so doing. Should this occur, refund of Entry Fees shall be at the discretion of the relevant Committee.
5. Stallions **MUST NOT** be led by Juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January, 2025.
6. Any animal deemed to be out of control or presenting danger to other exhibits must be removed from the ring at the request of the Judge, Steward or Committee.
7. The Committee, any of its Officers, Assistants & stewards shall not in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants, or any other members of the public or to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought into the showground or to any premises used in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving the same.
8. Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their assistants & riders/handlers & all persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to the orders of Stewards or Judges.
9. **DOGS – All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.** Please clean up after your dog.
10. **OBJECTIONS** shall be made in writing with the Objector's full name & address within 1 hour of the class concerned and lodged with the Shetland & Miniature Horse Secretary, together with the sum of £50 deposit. The sum will be refunded if the objection is sustained, but if it is not sustained the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of Trawden and District Agricultural Society. The Committee reserves the right to refer the objection to the Society or Association under whose rules the class is being run.
11. It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors carry adequate Public Liability Insurance. The Society does not accept any liability for any injury or damage sustained by any third party whatsoever.
12. The Judge's decision is **FINAL**. The Committee reserves the right to substitute, add or remove any Judge from any class or championship.
13. The number of animals which will give an individual show in any class shall be entirely the decision of the Judge(s).
14. All animals must be sound. All Judges have the right to request an examination of an animal by the Official Veterinary Surgeon. If, in his / her opinion the animal is not deemed fit to continue, it will be led from the ring & will not be presented for judging in any ring for the remainder of the day.
15. **DISEASE** - Any animal found to be suffering from any contagious or infectious disease shall be removed from the showground immediately at the request of the Official Veterinary Surgeon. Any animal found to be affected in this manner will be further disqualified from competing & must be removed from the show field by the exhibitor without delay.
16. **FLU VACCINATIONS** - It is recommended that all exhibitors ensure that horses & ponies have an up to date certificate of vaccination against equine flu which should be available for examination if required. **FULL PASSPORT MUST ACCOMPANY EVERY EQUINE IN TRANSIT.**
17. There will be **NO** provision of Farrier services on the field. Exhibitors are recommended to ensure all farrier work is carried out prior to the show.
18. **NO MUCKING OUT ON THE FIELD** – Please take home all waste
19. Competitors are requested **NOT** to telephone the Show Office with queries concerning times of commencement of classes or numbers of entries. This information **WILL NOT BE GIVEN** due to pressure of time. Please allow plenty of time for your arrival prior to your first class. All Entry Forms must be completed in full. **ENTRIES** (inc. online entries) **CLOSE 27th July 2025.**

SPSBS AFFILIATION RULES 2025

Classes must be confined to Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals)

Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. All entire males aged 2 years and over must display a stallion disc.

There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 yrs old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 yrs old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 yrs or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring.

- SP5 **Standard Shetland Stallion**
Winner receives the Hapton Animal Feeds Silver Salver donated by John Makinson (Hapton Animal Feeds).
- SP6 **Standard Mare 4yrs or over** with or without own foal at foot
- SP7 **Standard Foal born 2025 progeny of mare in SP6**
We retain the right to amalgamate this class with SP8 in the event of low entries
Winner receives the Smithson Trophy.
- SP8 **Standard Yearling** Colt/Filly/Gelding
We retain the right to amalgamate this class with SP7 in the event of low entries
- SP9 **Standard 2 Year & 3 Year old** Colt/Filly/Gelding
- SP10 **Standard Gelding** 4 Years or over
Winner receives the Carus Trophy

SP11 **Standard Coloured** any age, any colour other than black.

Standard Adult 4 years & over Champion (1st & 2nd place from SP5, SP6, SP10, SP11 to compete) Winner £10

Standard Junior Champion – Under 4yearss (1st & 2nd place from SP7, SP8, SP9, SP11 to compete) Winner £10

1st from Standard Adult & 1st from Standard Junior to compete in Overall Supreme Championship.

SP18 **Miniature Coloured** any age, any colour other than black.
