TICKETING

All exhibitors will be required to have an e-ticket or wristband to gain entry to the show field. Adult exhibitors will receive an exhibitor's e-ticket to the showground with a minimum of two entries. Additional prepaid e-tickets can be purchased at the time of class entry at £10 for adults (£14 on gate) and £6 for children aged 6 and over (£6 on gate). Children under 6 are admitted free of charge and do not require a ticket. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to bring a valid e-ticket or wristband with them on the day.

GENERAL REMARKS AND STRIPULATIONS

Exhibitors are responsible for complying with all regulations from all statutory bodies including all movement licenses and restrictions.

Throughout the duration of the show Stanley House Vets, Colne are the Society's on duty vets, should any sheep require emergency care by our named Vets, the exhibitor of that animal will be expected to cover this cost. Exhibitors enter the show field at their own risk.

The Trawden and District Agricultural Society and its members, secretary and directors accept no responsibility for any losses incurred on the show field. Exhibitors must have Public Liability Insurance which covers which covers them when away from the holding.

We also reserve the right to cancel any classes or indeed the show, should abandonment be necessary. Refunds will not be made.

Should your vehicle/s and/or equipment require towing onto/ from the show field in the event of inclement weather, the trustees, organising committee, nor any of their servants, be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage sustained by the applicants, their property, or their assistants. The Society accepts no liability whatsoever and should the applicant not agree to the terms then they will be left to organise their own entrance/exit onto the show field, except in the event that your vehicle is causing an obstruction to other traffic or a show entrance or exit and cannot be moved by you within a very short time frame to allow the free flow of traffic again. In these circumstances the society will be permitted to move the vehicle by whatever means necessary and subject to causing as little damage as possible to the vehicle but will accept no liability for any damage as a result of the same.

Sheep Conditions of entry:

1. All sheep must be penned by 9:30am. (please state number of pens required on entry form).
2. All sheep must be accompanied by the two ARAMS DEFRA movement licence forms both on and off and this must be completed and handed in to the Sheep secretary's marquee prior to unloading.
3. Sheep that are MV accredited should state so on the entry form and must be accompanied by the appropriate completed SAC form which should be handed into the Sheep Secretary's marquee prior to unloading.
4. Exhibitors are to abide by the current regulations regarding tail docking.
5. All sheep to have been sheared this year.
6. If insufficient entries in any class, the sheep section secretary reserves the right to amalgamate classes.
7. All sheep to remain on the showfield until after the grand parade

Strictly NO vehicles without livestock trailers will be permitted in the livestock areas
