Membership of BSPA is not a requirement for classes 124-125. For classes 120–127 all stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA and have a BSPA stallion ID card which must be carried at all times and produced on request. All stallions must wear a BSPA Stallion Disc. For class 128 all stallions must be graded with a recognised equine society. No rider under 14 yrs may exhibit a stallion in any class.

Classes 124-127 are qualifiers for the WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS OF COLOUR National Champion of Champions 2022, to be held at College Equestrian Centre, Keysoe, Bedfordshire in September, provided owners/handlers/riders are members of BSPA and Horses/Ponies are registered with BSPA prior to the Show, membership & qualification cards to be shown in the ring and signed at the time of qualification. However membership is not a requirement for entry into these classes. Non-members will not qualify. Classes 124-127 – 1st - 3rd qualify, plus h/p Youngstock and h/p Traditional or Native pony not standing 1st - 3rd. Class 128 – 1st - 3rd qualify or 1st - 4th when class exceeds 10.
