The Second Round Champions will go on to compete at the Olympia Anthony Evans SSADL Home Produced Supreme Final at Olympia, The London International Horse Show in December 2019. Once a competitor has qualified for the Olympia Grand Final, they may continue to compete at any 2nd Round Qualifiers, but they will NOT be eligible to enter the Olympia Qualifying Championships. In this instance the second placed competitor will be eligible for this championship. Once a competitor has qualified for Olympia in the Ridden section, they are NOT allowed to qualify in the In-Hand section and vice versa.
