Class 1
Young Handler 9yrs & Under
Handlers to have attained their 3rd Birthday but not to have attained their 10th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be registered with the SPSBS. Correctly fitting skull caps must be worn by all handlers. No colts or stallions.
Class 2
Young Handler 10-17 yrs
Handlers to have attained their 10th Birthday but not to have attained their 18th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be registered with the SPSBS. Correctly fitting skull caps must be worn by all handlers under the age of 14 years. No colts or stallions.
Class 3
Lead Rein Pony
Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday by the day of their class and not to have attained their 9th birthday on 1st January of year of show. Ponies must be registered with SPSBS. Ponies must be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle with the reins going directly from the bit to the rider's hands. The lead rein must be attached to the nose band only.
Class 4
First Ridden Pony
Off leading rein, riders must have attained their 3rd birthday by the day of their class and not to have attained their 12th birthday on 1st January of year of show. Ponies must be registered by the SPSBS. Ponies can be shown in any suitable bridle. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show.
Class CH1
Ridden Championship
For 1st & 2nd Prize winners from classes 3-4

Standard Colt Foal

Colt foal born in the current year to be registered or eligible for registration with the SPSBS

Class 6

Standard Filly Foal

Filly foal born in the current year to be registered or eligible for registration with the SPSBS

Class CH2

Standard Foal Championship

For 1st & 2nd Prize winners from classes 5-6

Class 7

Standard Yearling

1 Year Old SPSBS Registered pony. Colt, filly or gelding.

Class 8

Standard 2 Year Old

2 Year Old SPSBS Registered pony. Colt, filly or gelding.

Class 9

Standard 3 Year Old

3 Year Old SPSBS Registered pony. Colt, filly or gelding.

Class 10

Standard Gelding

SPSBS Registered gelding age four years or over.

Class 11

Standard Mare

SPSBS Registered mare age four years or over.

Class 12

Standard Stallion

SPSBS Registered Stallion age four years or over. Stallions must have an 's' number and have been successfully through either the SPSBS stallion

assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPSBS voluntary veterinary examination.

1 Year Old SPSBS Registered pony. Colt, filly or gelding.

2 Year Old SPSBS Registered pony. Colt, filly or gelding.
Class 17
Miniature 3 Year Old
3 Year Old SPSBS Registered pony. Colt, filly or gelding.

Class 18
Miniature Gelding
SPSBS Registered gelding age four years or over.
Class 19
Miniature Mare
SPSBS Registered mare age four years or over.

Miniature Stallion
SPSBS Registered Stallion age four years or over. Stallions must have an 's' number and have been successfully through either the SPSBS stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPSBS voluntary veterinary examination.

Class 21

Best Progeny Group

For pairs or groups of three, Standard or Miniature, any age. Open to SPSBS Registered ponies only. Ponies to be closely related and fall into one of the following categories: **A)** Two or Three ponies with the same Dam and/or Sire. **B)** Dam or Sire with one or two of their offspring eg: Mare with a daughter.

Please ensure if you are entering colts 2 years old or over they are correctly bitted and display a colt/stallion badge.

Not Before 1pm

Class 22

Best Novice pony

Combination never to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any affiliated showing classes before 1st January in the current year. Ridden or In-hand

Class 23

Best Solid Coloured Pony

Pony any age, standard or mini to be of one colour eg: chestnut, black, grey

Class 24

Best Broken Coloured Pony

Pony any age, standard or mini to be broken coloured eg: piebald, skewbald or spotted.

Class 25

Best Mare

Mare any age, standard or mini

Class 26

Best Gelding
Gelding any age, standard or mini
Class 27
Best Veteran Pony
Pony aged 15 years or over, standard or mini
Class 28
Fancy Dress
Pony any age, standard or mini. To be dressed up in any theme. Outfits must be safely secured and may included up to two ponies and as many additional handlers/children as the exhibitor wishes. NO DOGS.

Rules

By entering the Show, you have agreed and accepted all these rules.

- 1) The organisers of this Show have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. The show asks that everyone takes due care to prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the officials and stewards.
- 2) All Exhibitors are strongly advised to have their own Public Liability Insurance.
- 3) All vehicles are parked at the risk of the owners and the organisers will not be liable for any damage to any exhibitor's property.
- 4) Basic First Aid is available on site. The organisers should be made aware of any injuries or accidents that take place at the event. All emergency services call out must be made by the organisers.
- 5) Complaints or objections must be made in writing and handed to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident and must be accompanied by £40 deposit. Returnable if the objection is upheld. Failure to follow the correct complaints procedure may result in individuals being removed from the show.
- 6) No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee.
- 7) The organisers reserve the right to limit entries and refuse entry to an exhibitor without giving a reason.
- 8) It is very strongly advised that ponies entering this show should have had at least their primary course of equine flu vaccinations.
- 9) The Judge's decision is final. The Judge is within his/her right to refuse awarding of prizes if he/she feels there is no deserving recipient forward.
- 10) All Ponies entered for classes 1 to 21 must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society. Ponies full name must be on the entry form along with their registration number.
- 11) SPSBS Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.
- 12) 3 years old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown.
- 13) All foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the Show.

- 14) All Stallions and Colts 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and should display a Stallion/ Colt Bridle Badge.
- 15) Stallions aged four and over entered in to in-hand or ridden classes at an SPSBS affiliated show, must have an 's' number and have been successfully through either the SPSBS stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPSBS voluntary veterinary examination.
- 16) Exhibitors should not kneel while in the ring.
- 17) There must be no colts or stallions in the Young Handlers classes.
- 18) Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or stallions in any In Hand classes.
- 19) Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years old and under have to wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the current Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 20) Riders of all ages must wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the current Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 21) If a Rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring. Rider dismounted and take no further part.
- 22) Whips and canes must not exceed 30"
- 23) Mobile phones are not permitted in the ring under any circumstance.
- 24) NO DOGS are permitted at this show
- 25) This Show is also run under the rules of the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society (SPSBS).
