

RULES

1. Exhibitors making entries for the Egg Show must comply by these rules.
2. No exhibits will be accepted to the Egg Show until payment has been made and booking form completed.
3. All exhibits for the Egg Show must be staged by 9.30am on the day of the show. Exhibits may be delivered in person to Tanya King at the Show ground between 4pm—6pm on the evening of 29th July with prior booking with the Egg show secretary.
4. Whilst every care and attention is taken with the Eggs at the Show, no responsibility is held for any loss or damage to the exhibits.
5. Plate numbers will be issued at the Egg Show tent on the morning of the Show.
6. Judging will commence at 10am on the day of the show.
7. The Judge's decision is final.
8. No exhibits are to be removed from the show before 4pm.
9. Exhibitors should provide the egg show secretary with a S.A.E if they enter more than 10 class entries to receive their exhibitors ticket. No SAE, no ticket.
10. Entries awarded rosettes or prize cards need to be collected on Show day unless a S.A.E is provided to the Egg Show secretary in advance or with prior approval from the Egg Show secretary.
11. The Show reserves the right to safely dispose of any uncollected exhibits by 6pm on Show Day.
